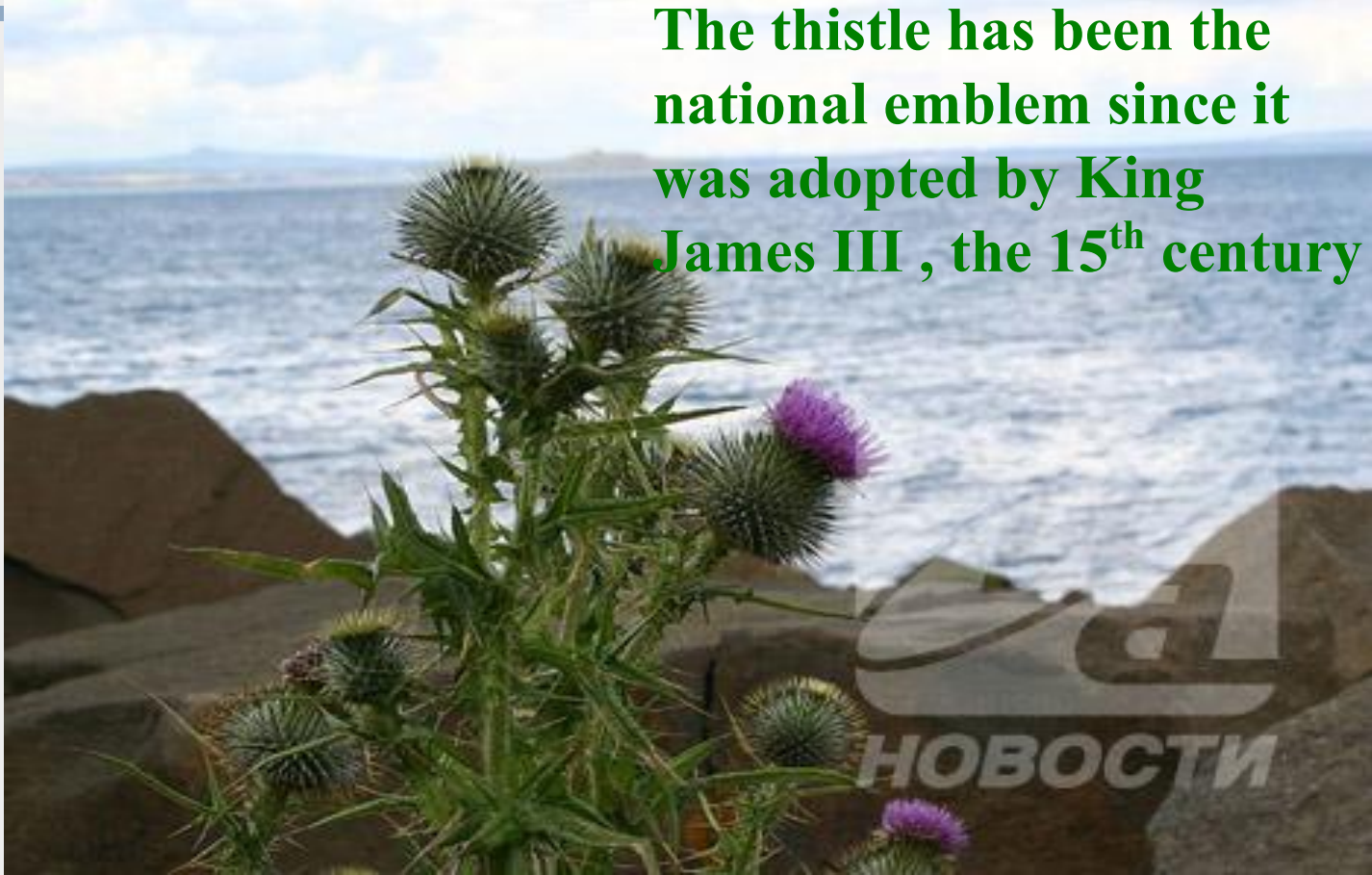
Scottish Flag

National Instrument

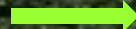
Perhaps, it was brought by The Romans. It was a favorite musical instrument of **King James I** in 16th century.



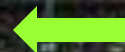

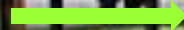

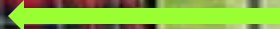

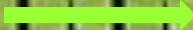

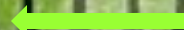

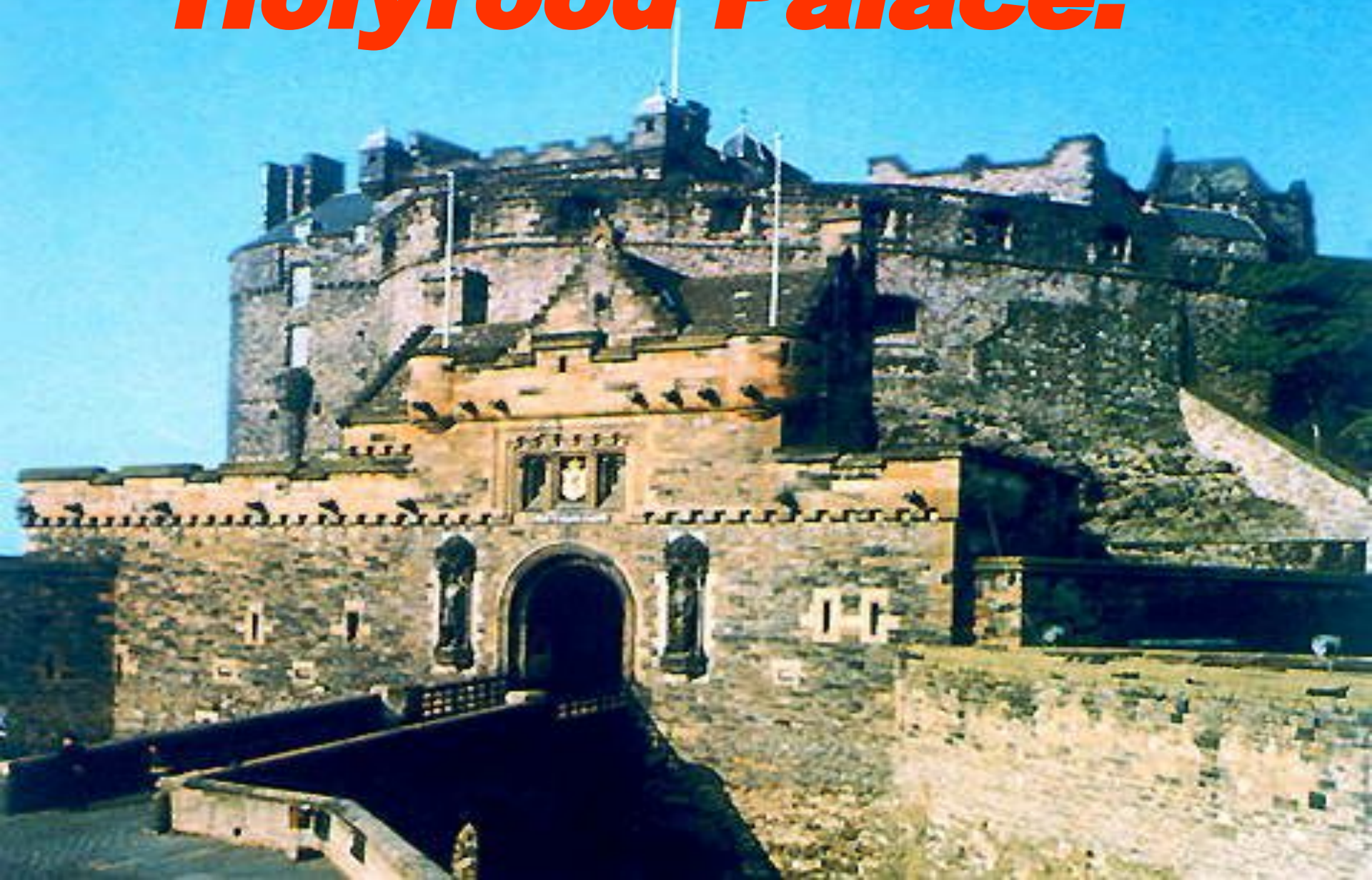

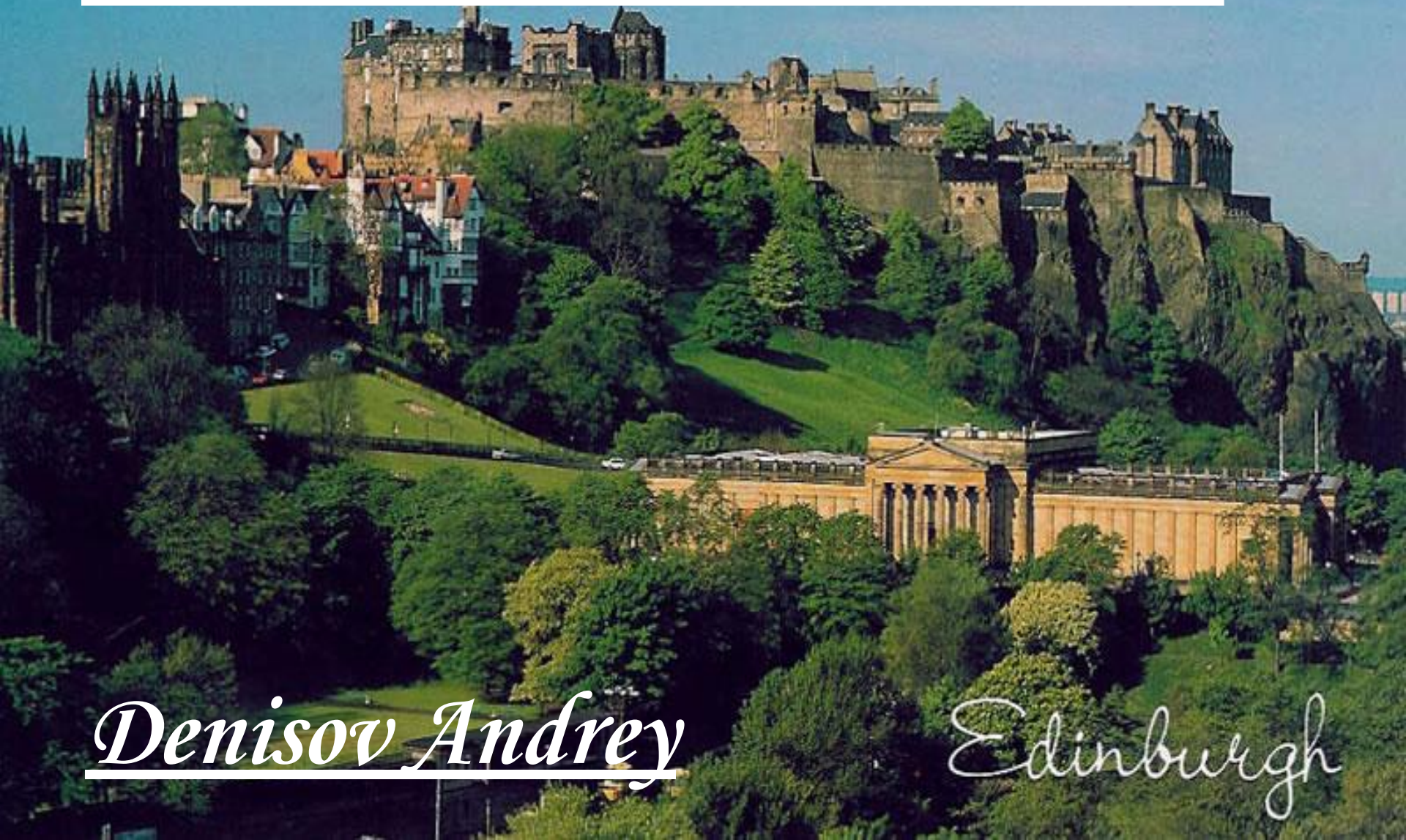
