

borrowings come into English from other European languages and some changes in the English grammar and phonetics.


the hypothesis:



the historic events taken place within the long period of the British history influenced greatly on the language of its people.


problems to be solved:

- to get acquainted with the most significant events in the history of England which are reflected in the language development of this country.




