

Present perfect

I have done a lot of work **today**
today, this week, since 1985, recently



1. It hasn't rained **this week.**
2. Have you seen **this morning?**
(it's still morning)

Past simple

I did a lot of work **yesterday**
yesterday, last week, from 1985 to 1995



1. It didn't rain **last week.**
2. Did you see Ann **this morning?**
(it's now afternoon or evening)

Present perfect is not used

~~The Chinese have invented printing.~~ → The Chinese invented printing.

~~Beethoven has been a great composer.~~ → Beethoven was a great composer.



Yesterday we worked well.
Today we have done much more
than usual.
