How one behaves online.

Be polite

Do not send messages which may hurt a person's feelings

Use proper language Avoid using inappropriate and offensive language.

Remember that nothing you write on the Internet is private. Anything written on the 'Net' can be read by anyone online.





Avoid sending the same message to the same people over and over again. This is called being a pest.

Never respond to rude or offensive messages. Just log off.

Avoid using ALL CAPS. It's considered shouting online.
