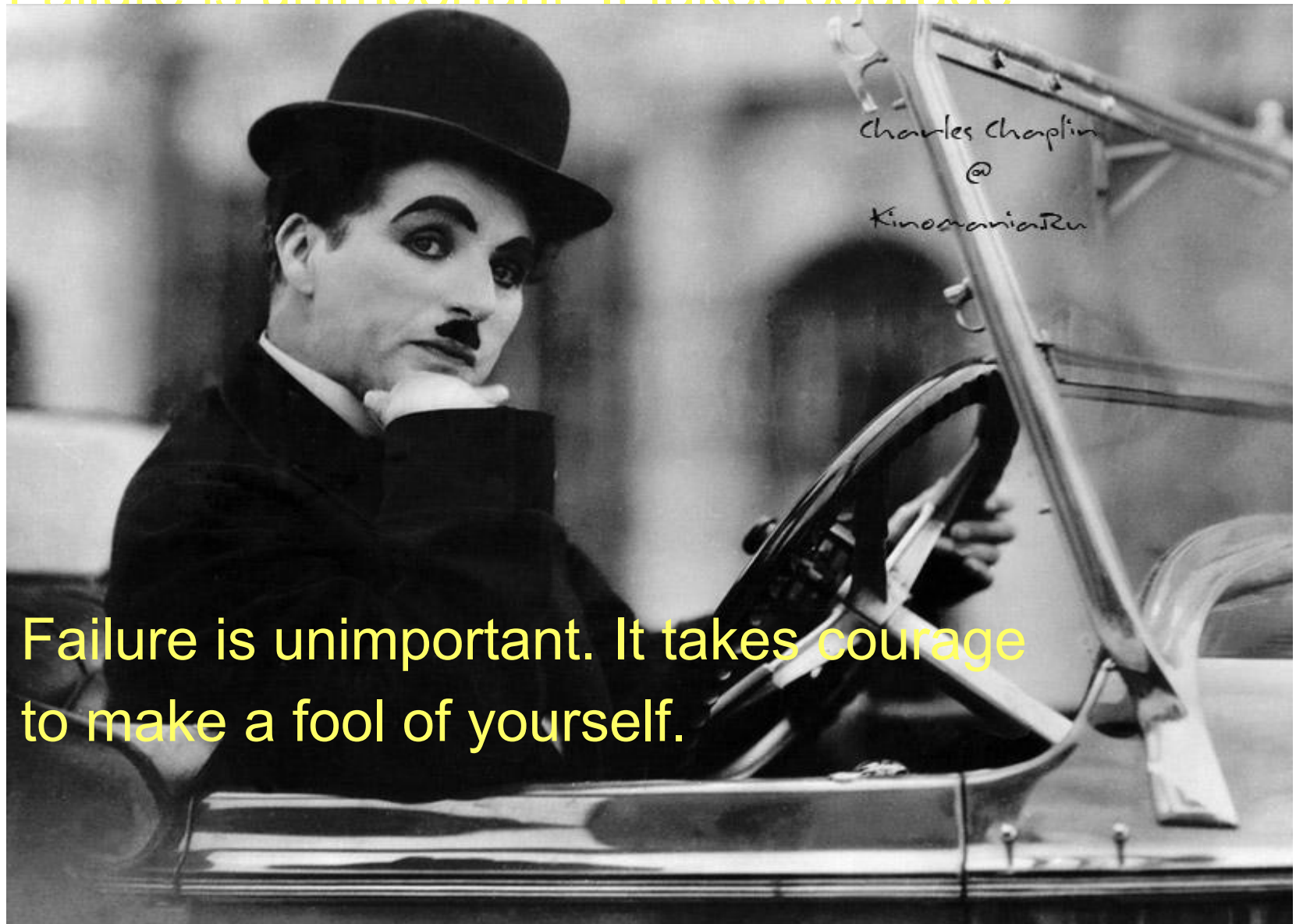

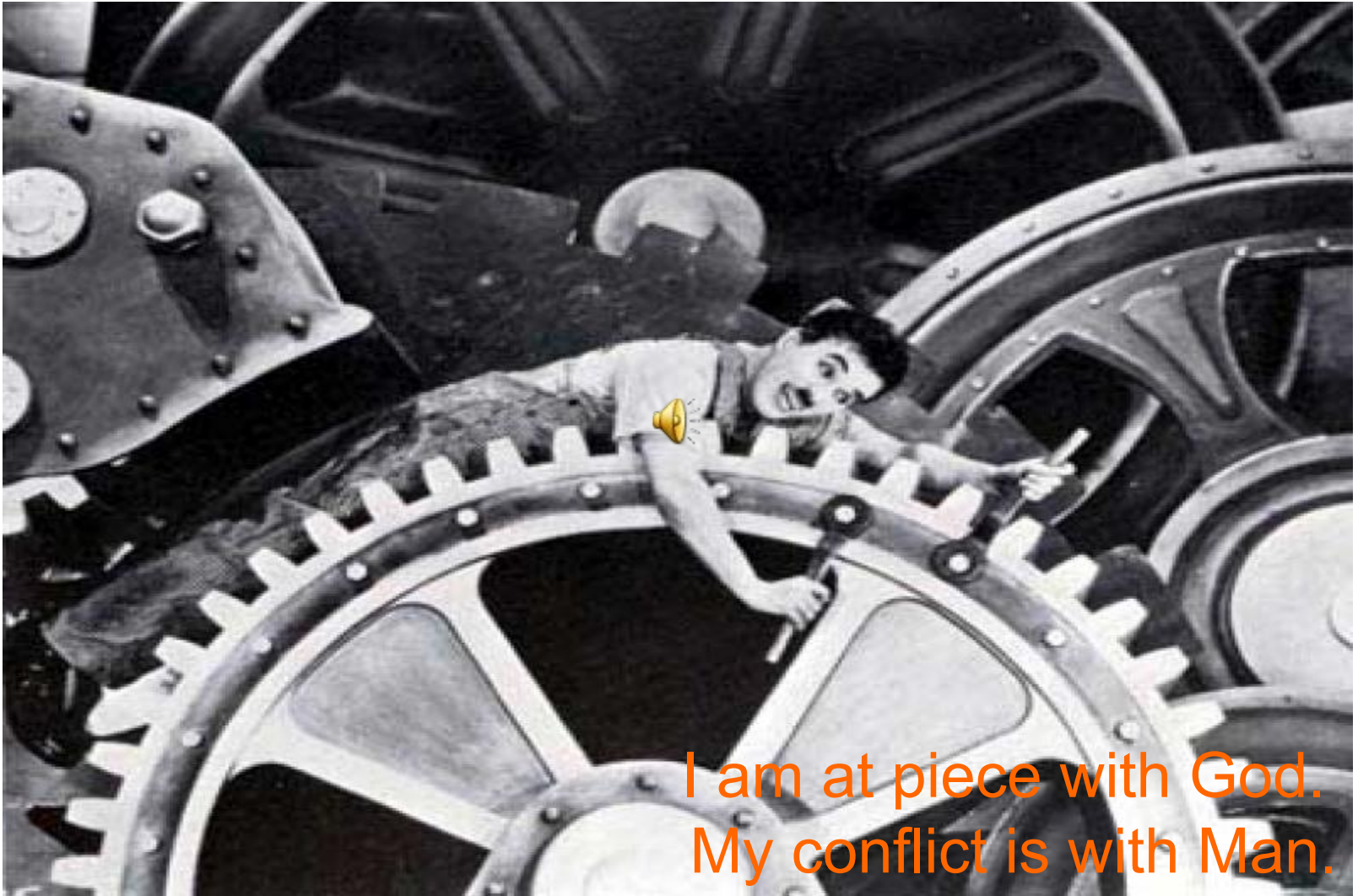


Failure is unimportant. It takes courage
