Dust from the volcano travelled all around the world.



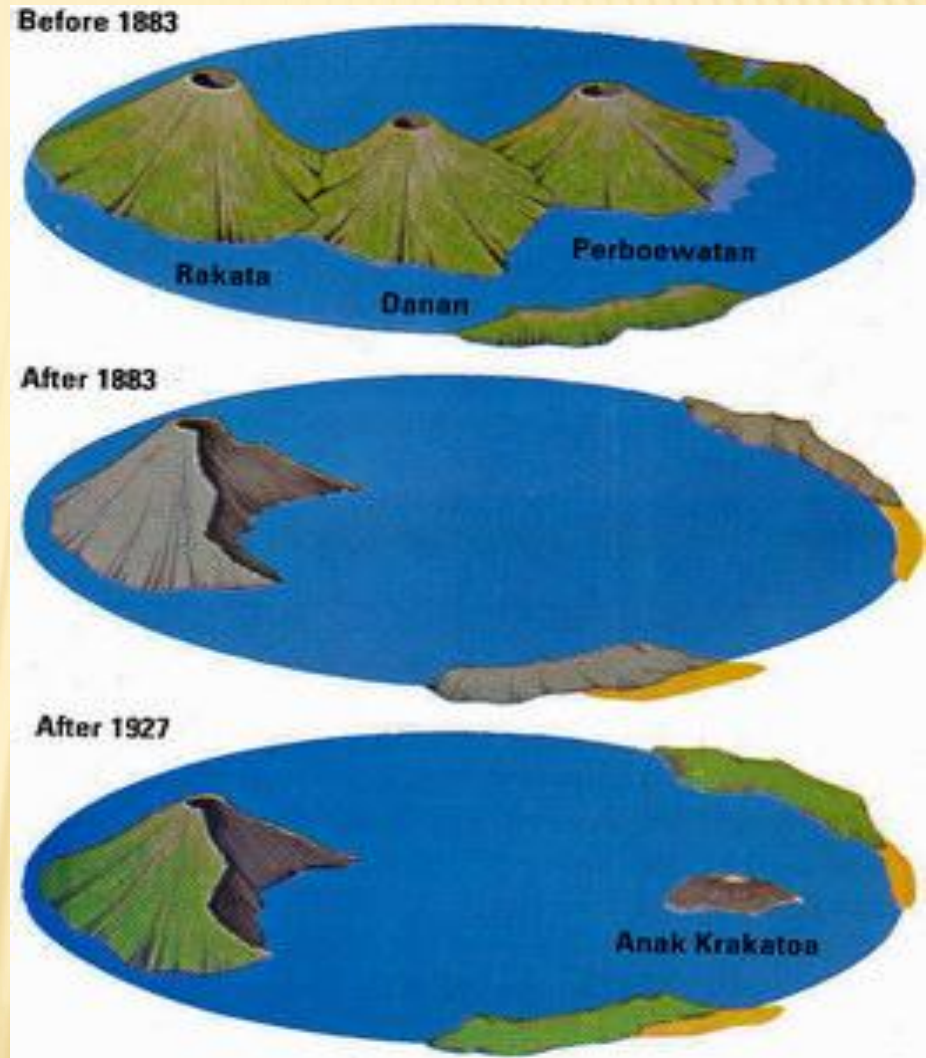


They were 15 metres high There were big waves
