- The problem number one contains communication with each other. At our age it's so important to choose a true friend who can listen to you, support in any situation, and advise something useful.

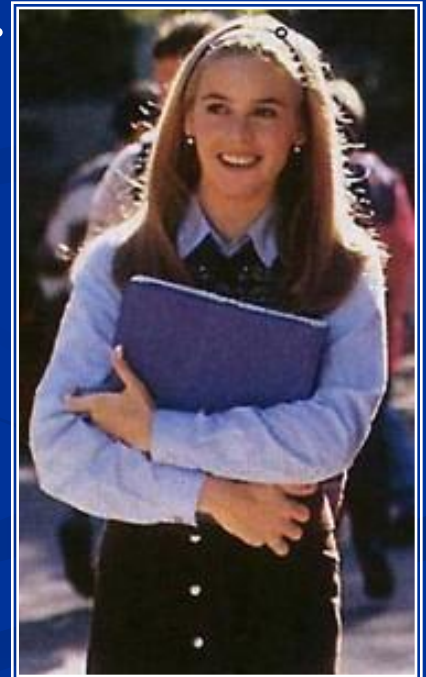

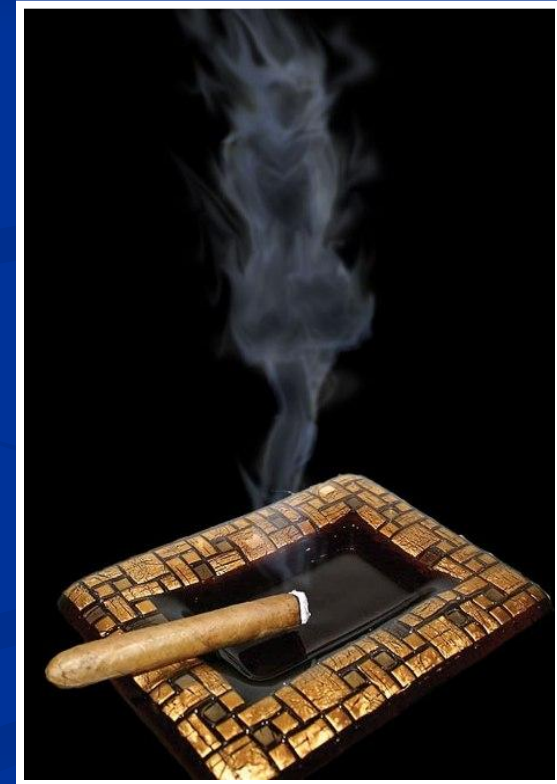
DRUG ADDICTION

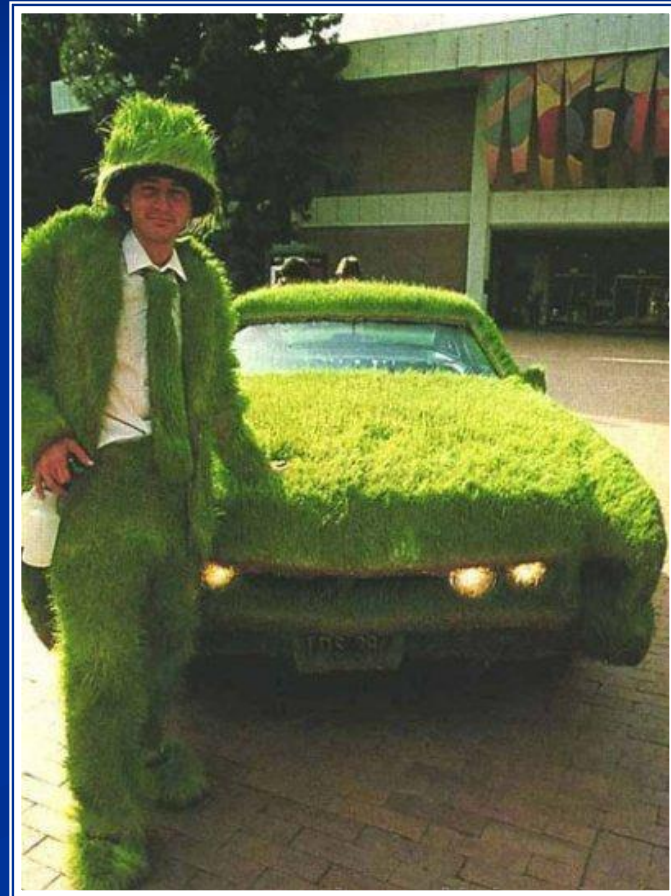
Girl Guides

The Youth Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament

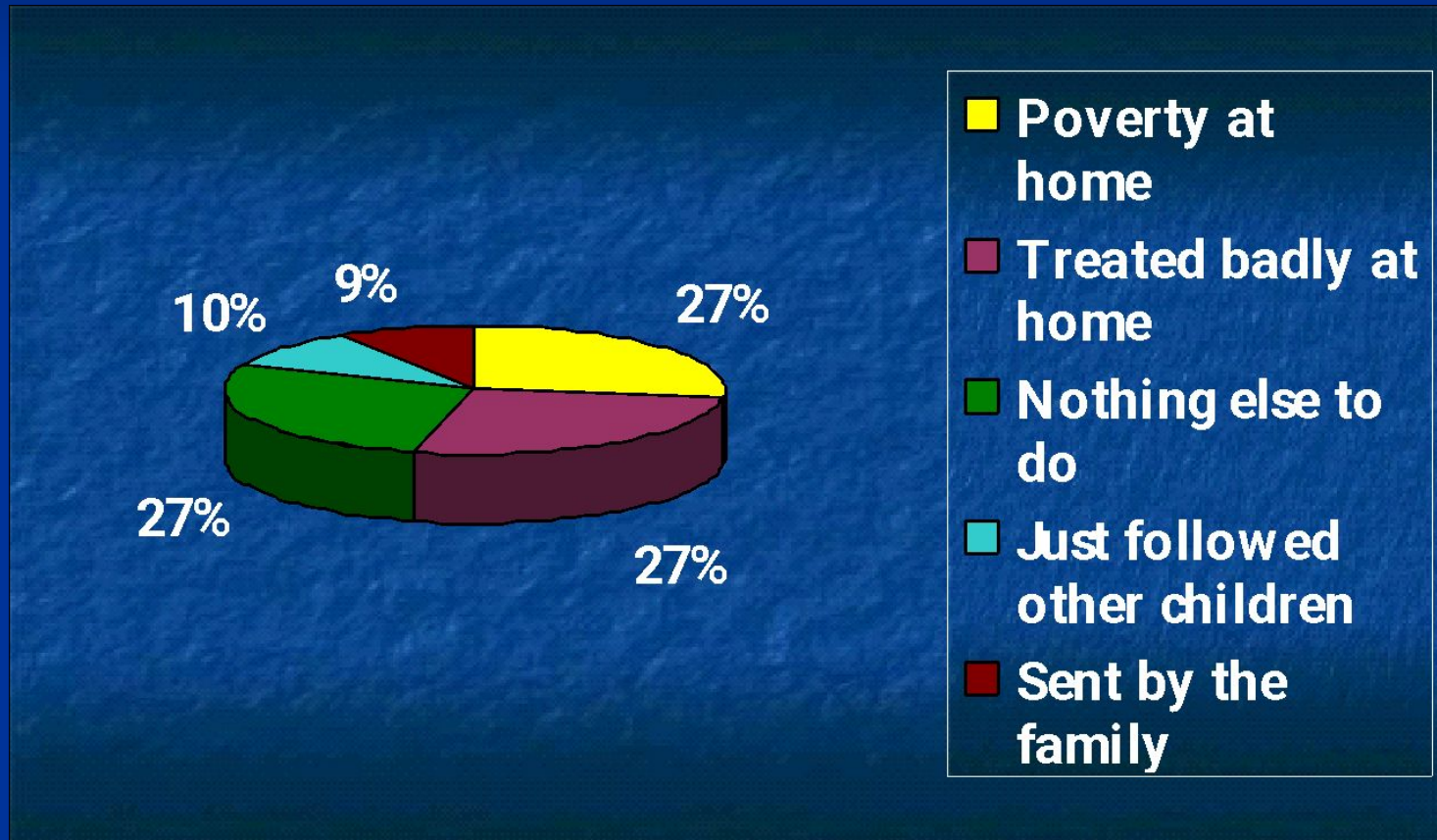

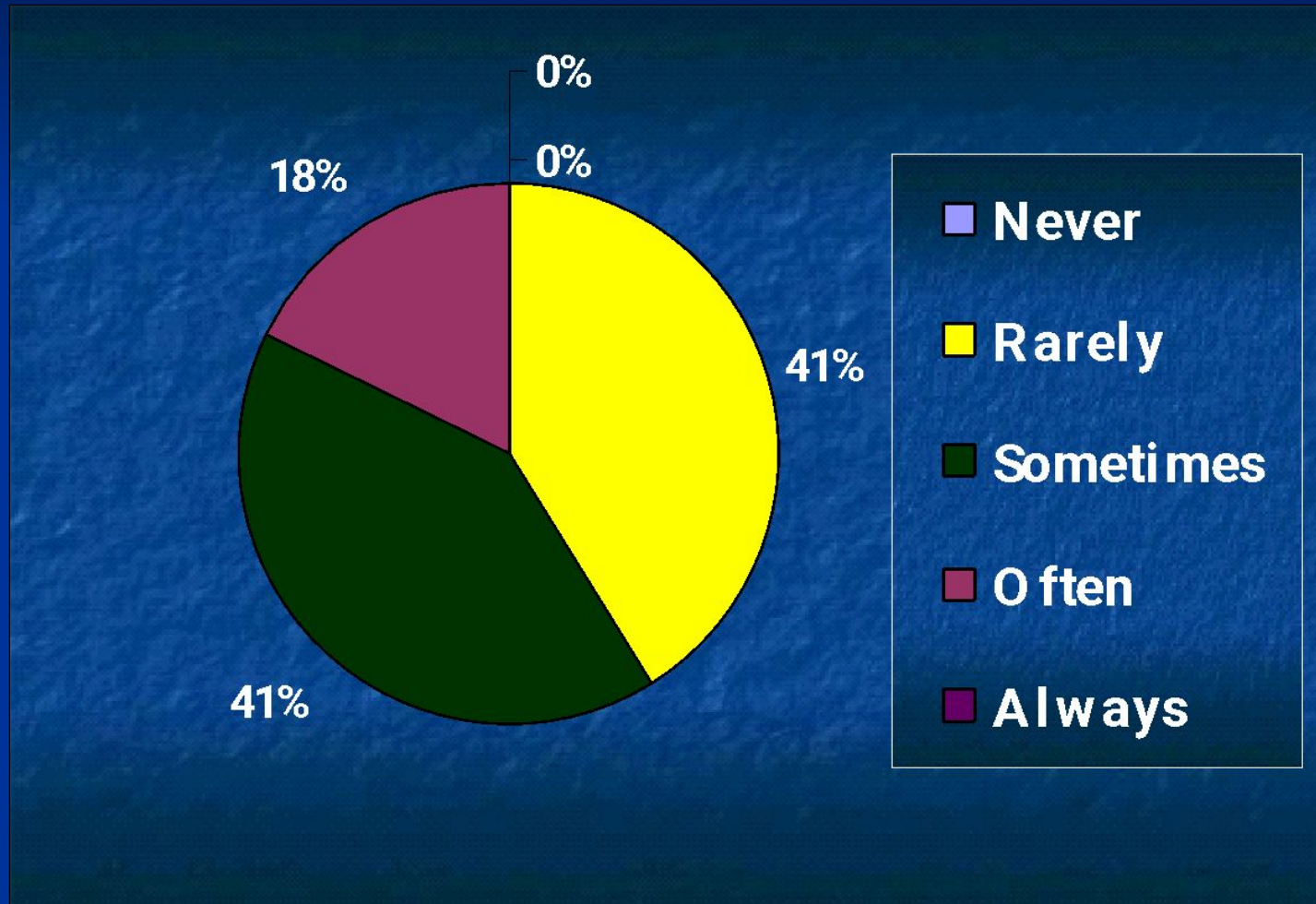
As you see, all these organizations deal with preserving and strengthening the social and political system existing in the country. Many of them have done and still are doing useful work providing leisure facilities for young people.

Street Children

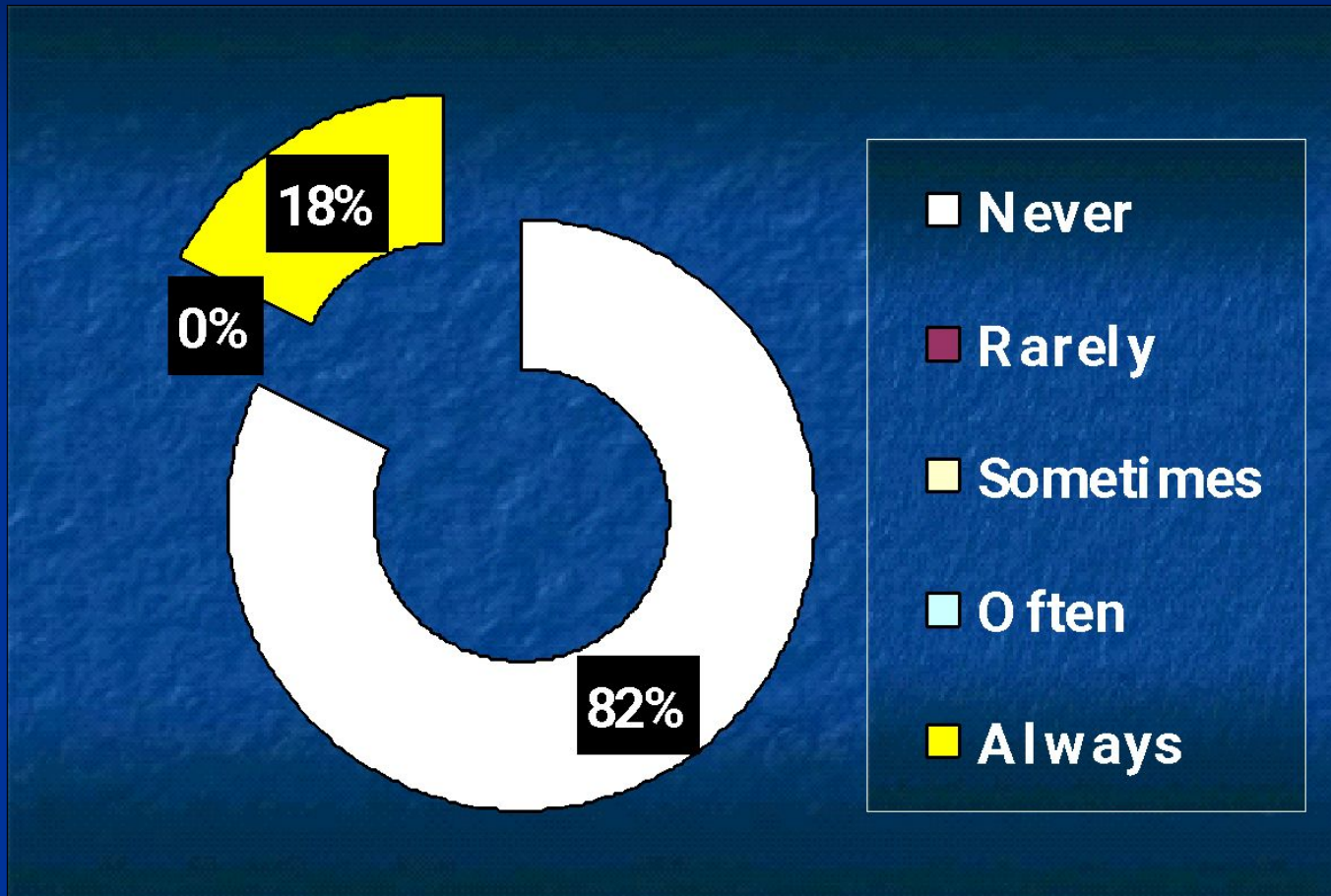
- 40 million children around the world spend their life on city streets.
- Why are they there?



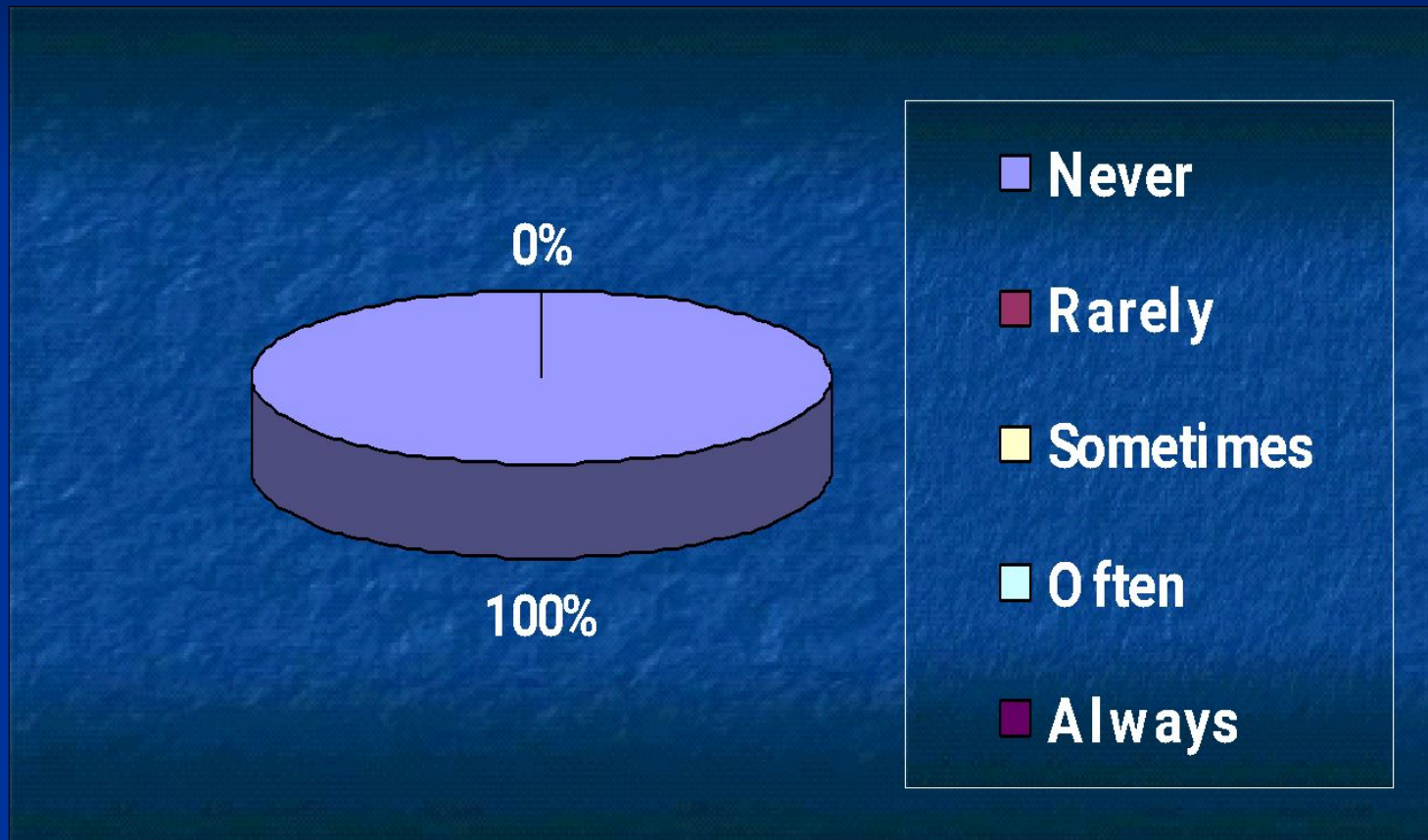
■ Do you argue with parents?



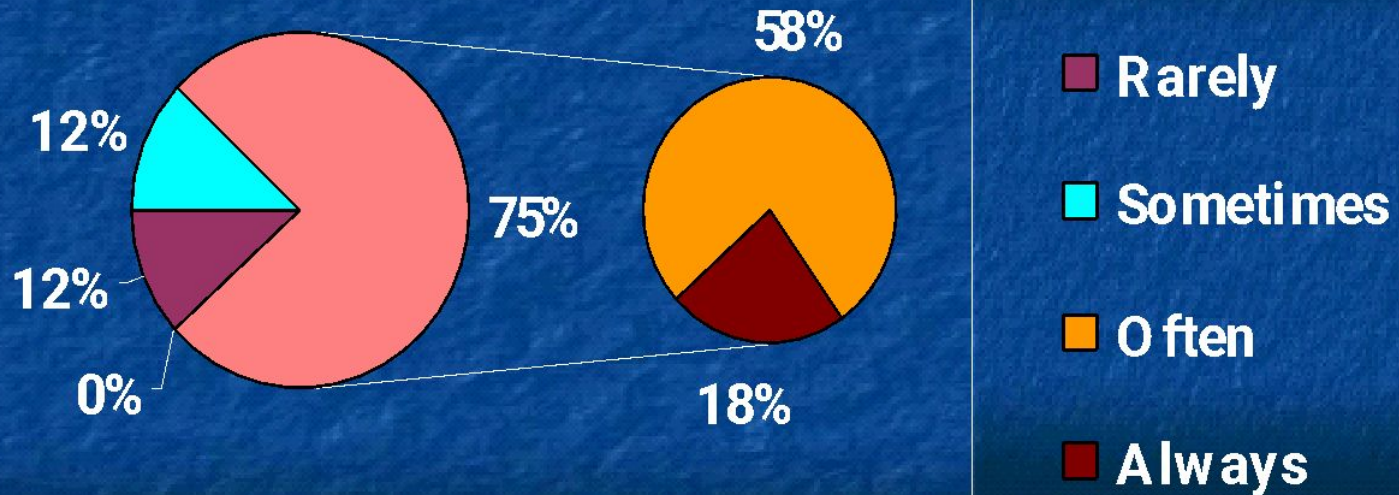
■ Do you smoke?



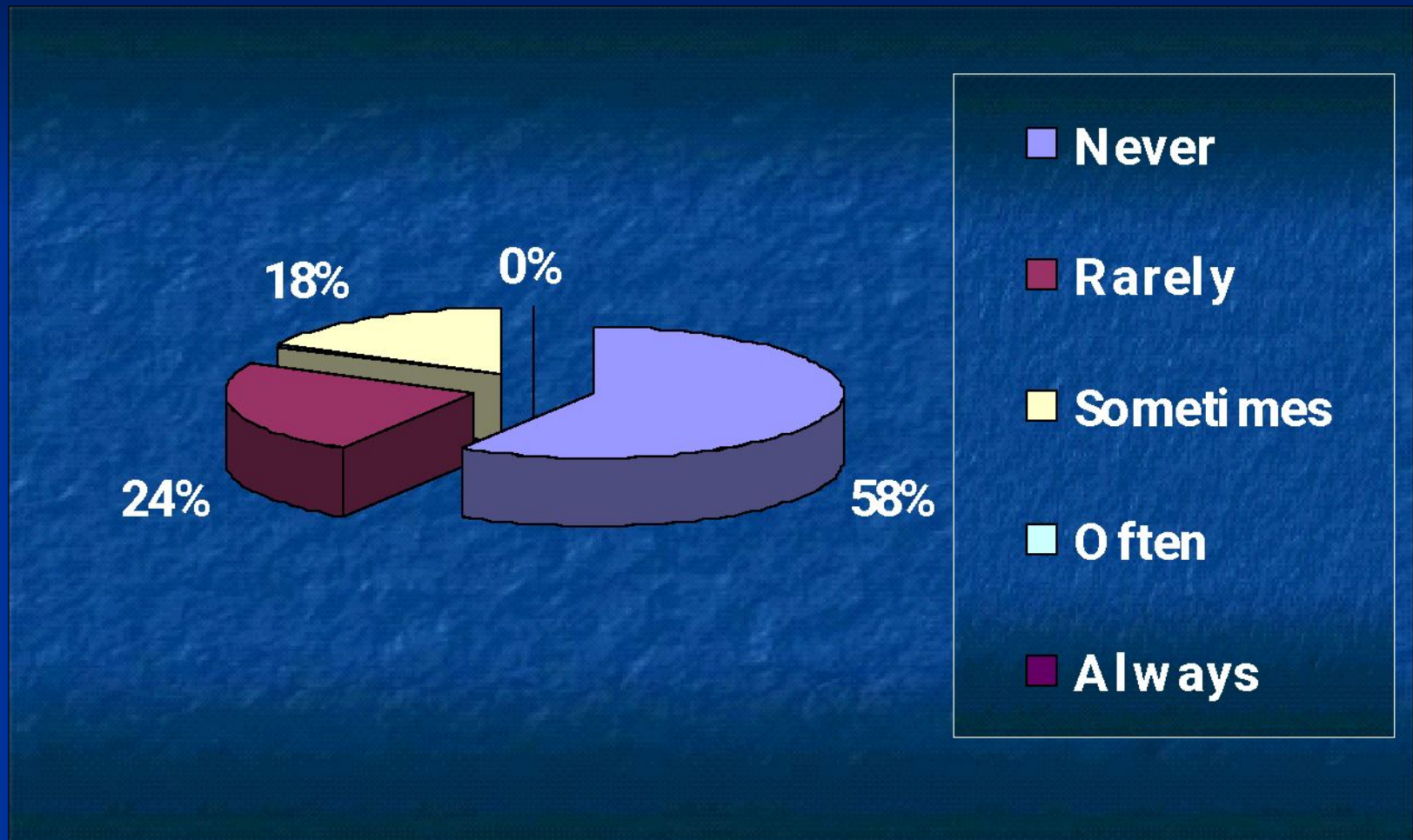
■ Do you take any drugs?
