In the era of rapid development of national industry of the population of Birmingham grew so quickly that it was called "the magic city."

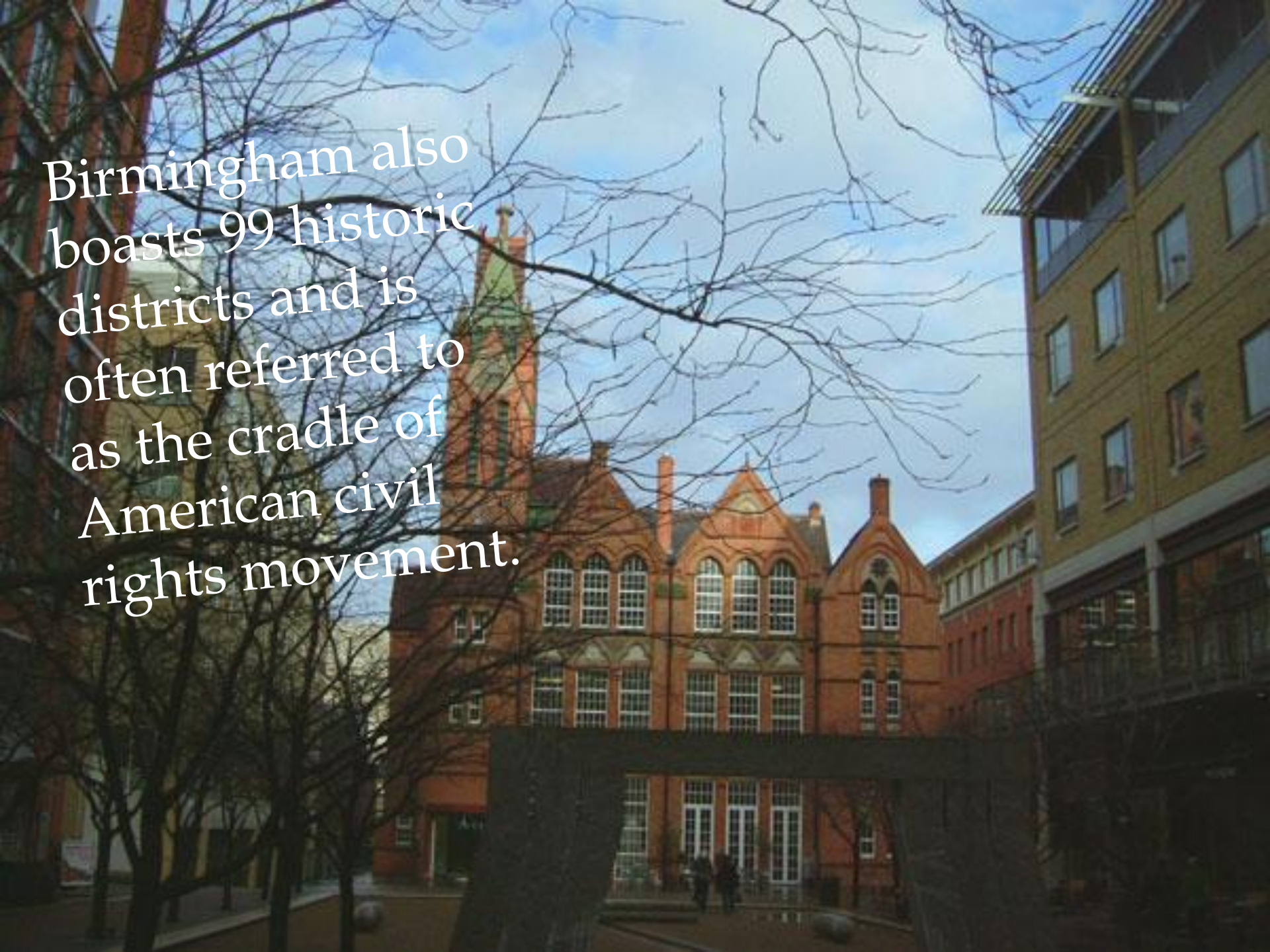


The city is the center of the West Midlands region and the second most populous city in England after London.
