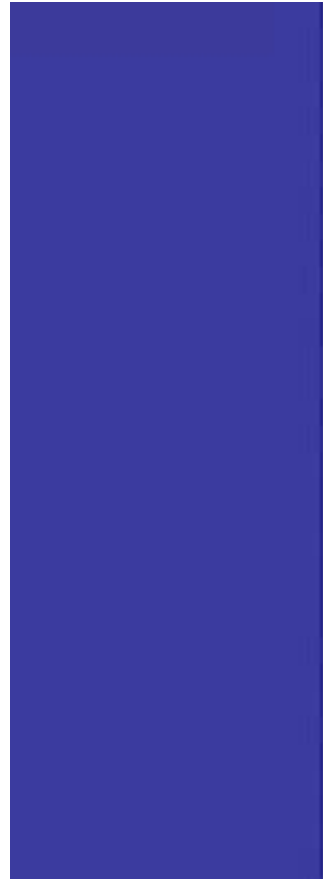

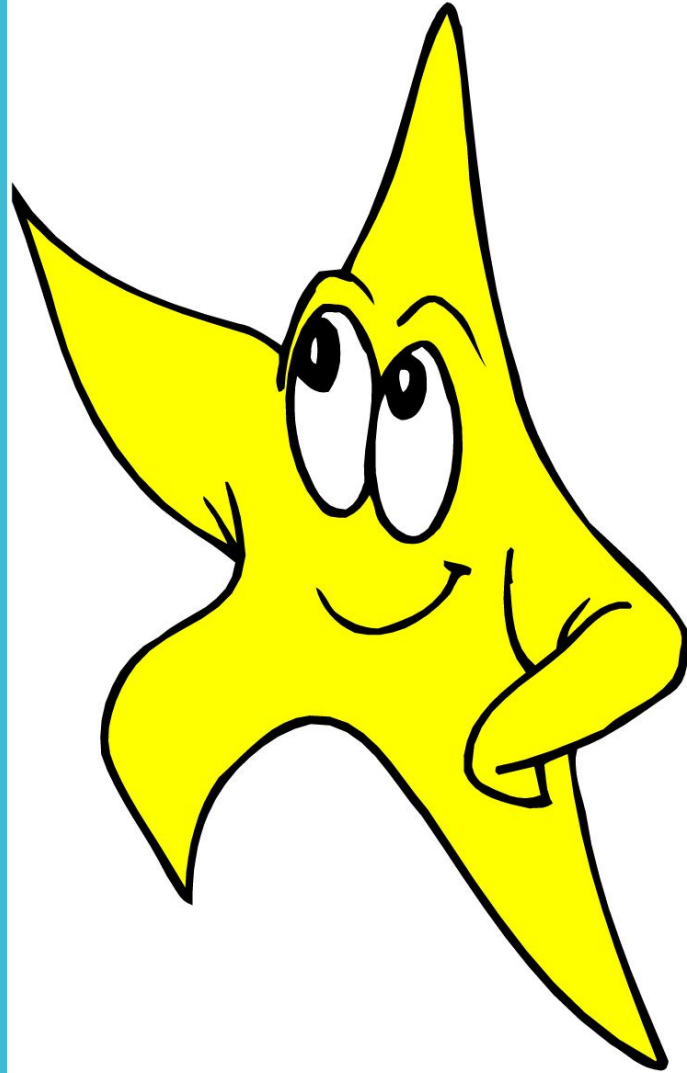

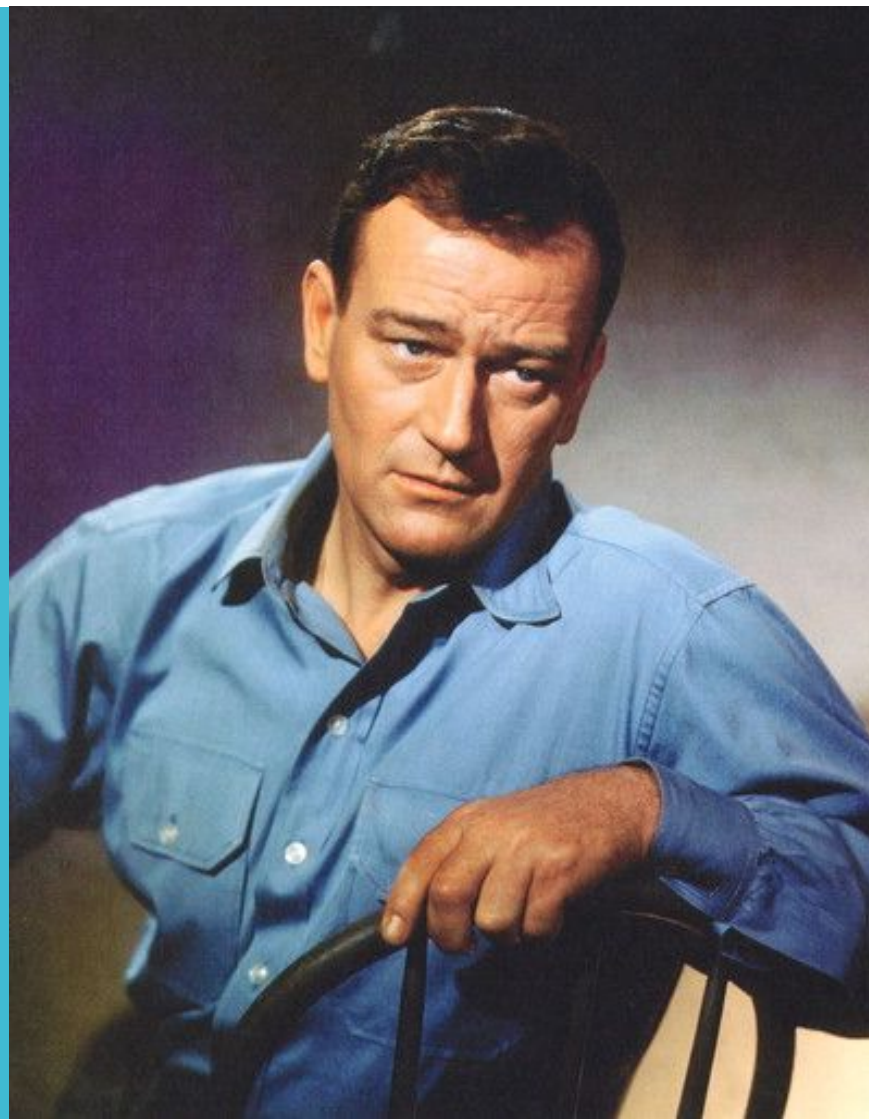


- *One-armed piano players must perform for free.*

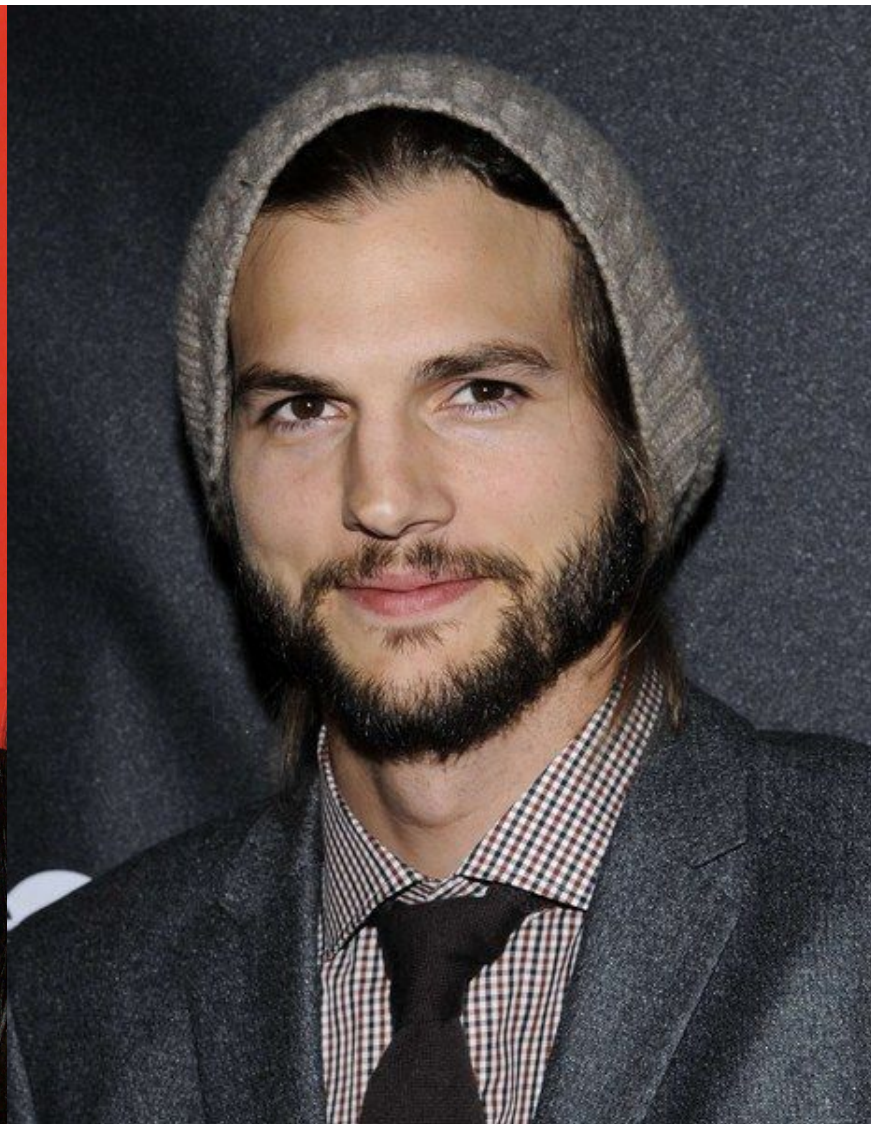
