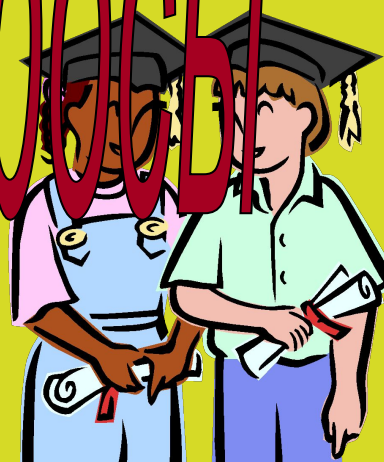

You haven't got a car, **have you?**
It was a good film, **wasn't it?**

Have you? и **wasn't it?** - вопросительные тэги (мини-вопросы, ставящиеся в конце предложения). В вопросительных тэгах используются вспомогательные глаголы.

Во временах present и past simple употребляются **do/does/did**:

- They came by car, **didn't they?**



В предложении с отрицанием (**negative sentence**) обычно используется утвердительный (**positive**) вопросительный тэг:

NEGATIVE STATEMENT

POSITIVE QUESTION TAG

My parents aren't very rich,

are they?

He isn't tall,

is he?

В утвердительном предложении (**positive sentence**) используется вопросительный тэг с отрицанием

POSITIVE STATEMENT

NEGATIVE QUESTION TAG

He is tall,

isn't he?

My parents are very rich,

aren't they?



Значение вопросительного тэга зависит от, того, как вы его произносите.

Если голос понижается, вы не задаете вопрос, а только спрашиваете у собеседника согласия с ВАШИМ мнением:

-Tom doesn't look very well today, **does he?**

-Но если голос повышается, то это настоящий вопрос:

You haven't seen Ann today, **have you?** No, I'm afraid not.



После **Let's...** вопросительным тэгом служит **shall we?**:

Let's go out for a walk, **shall we?**

После повелительного наклонения (**do/ don't do something**) тэгом является **will you?**:

Open the door, **will you?**

Don't be late, **will you?**

Заметьте, что говорят **aren't I? (=am I not):**
I'm late, **aren't I?**
