
# THE NATIONAL SYMBOLS OF AUSTRALIA

#### THE FLAG

- adopted 3 September 1901
- includes the Southern Cross, Union Flag and Commonwealth Star





### THE NATIONAL ANTHEM

- Advance Australia Fair
- by Peter Dodds McCormick
- first performed in 1878
- replaced God Save the Queen in 1984

### THE NATIONAL COLOURS

- adopted 19 April 1984
- prior to 1984:
  - red, white and blue
  - blue and gold
  - green and gold



### THE NATIONAL FLORAL EMBLEM

- Golden Wattle (Acacia pycnantha)
- adopted 19 August 1988
- flowers in late winter and spring



### THE NATIONAL GEMSTONE

- adopted 27 July 1992
- opal production was worth \$71.4 million to Australia in 2003

Red Kangaroo (Macropus rufus)






