WHAT IS WALMART?

- 1962 Walten Brothers open the first Walmart store in Arkansas
- 1970 Walmart becomes publicly held company
- 1990 becomes the largest national retailer
- 1991 international expansion (Mexico)
- 1993 creation of "Great Value"
- 2003 becomes the largest corporation in the world
- > 2005 controls about 20% of the retail grocery and consumables business
- 2007 new slogan, "Save money. Live better."
- 2011 new "Walmart To Go" home delivery system

WALMART STORES IN THE WORLD

- Discount department stores with size varying from 51.000 to 224.000 square feet.
- Include general merchandise and a selection of groceries.
- In 1990, Walmart opened its first Bud's Discount City in Bentonville, AR.
- As of January 2014, there were 510 Walmart discount stores in the US.

WALMART DISCOUNT STORES

- Hypermarkets with size varying from 98.000 to 261.000 square feet.
- Include a full-service supermarket (meat and poultry, baked goods, delicatessen, frozen foods, dairy products, garden produce, and fresh seafood).
- May include a garden center, pet shop, pharmacy, Tire & Lube Express, optical center, one-hour photo processing lab, portrait studio, etc.
- In 1988, the first Supercenter opened in Washington, MO.
- As of January 2014, there were 3.273 Walmart Supercenters in the US.
- The largest Supercenter is located in Albany, NY. The 2nd largest is in Lewisburg, PA.

WALMART SUPERCENTER



- Grocery stores with size about 42.000 square feet.
- Include full lines of groceries, pharmaceuticals, health and beauty aids, photo developing services, and a limited selection of general merchandise.
- ▶ In 1998, the 1st store opened in Bentonville, AR.
- As of January 2014, there are 333 Walmart Neighborhood Markets.



WALMART NEIGHBORHOOD MARKET

- Small discount stores with a range of services from simple grocery shopping to check cashing and even gasoline service.
- The concept is focused on small towns that are not able to support a larger store, and in large cities where physical space is at a premium.
