Nooruz

Nooruz is the favorite holiday of the Muslim people of the Ancient East. The first day of Nooruz is on the 21st of March.

This day is the first of New Year for Muslim people. Traditionally on this day they are preparing sumolok.



Orozo Ait



Orozo Ait comes after the mounts called "ramadan", during which time religious people can't eat during the day. After sunset they are allowed to do so. During the three days of Orozo Ait, believers usually visit the places where the dead members of their family or closest family friends rest.



Kurman Ait

“Kurban Mairam” or we usually call it “Kurman Ait” is a holiday of sacrifice. This is two months and ten days after Orozo Ait.

The link between all these holidays, it seems, is to show respect and love towards, ancestors, God, older people, other people and nature.
