Astana is a beautiful modern city.

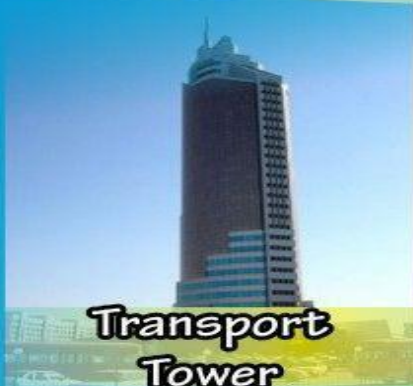

UNESCO "City of Peace".*

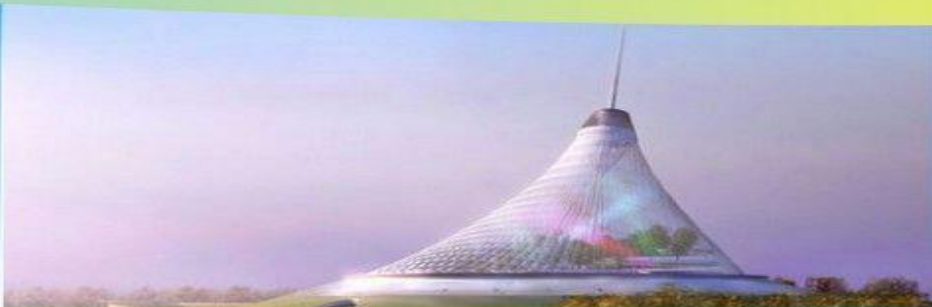


*Almaty is the largest city in Kazakhstan,

capital' of Kazakhstan.*





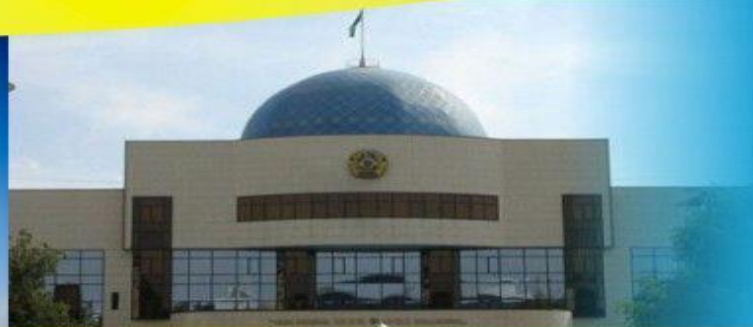

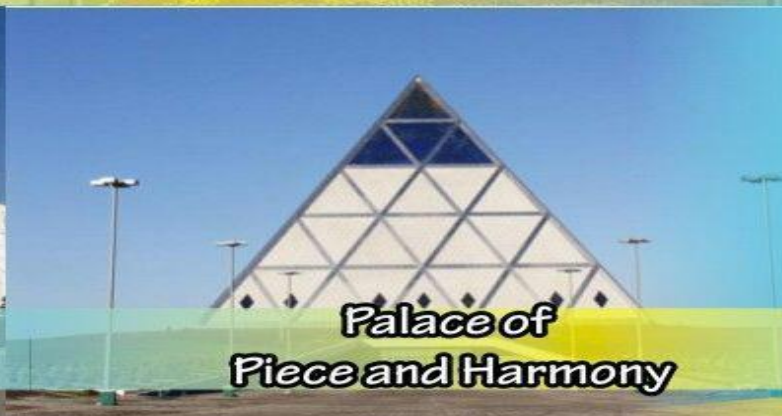
