Coach - Strelnikov Alexander, master of sports of international class, honored sport of the Republic of Kazakhstan, representative of CSKA, the first lieutenant.



Summer Olympics 2012 in London, won the Japanese Yasuhiro Suzuki (25-11), Venezuelan Gabriel Maestre Perez (20-9), Russian Andrey Castle (18-12), the host of the competition won in the finals - the British Freddie Evans with a score of 17 9 and became the Olympic champion in the category up to 69 kg.
