



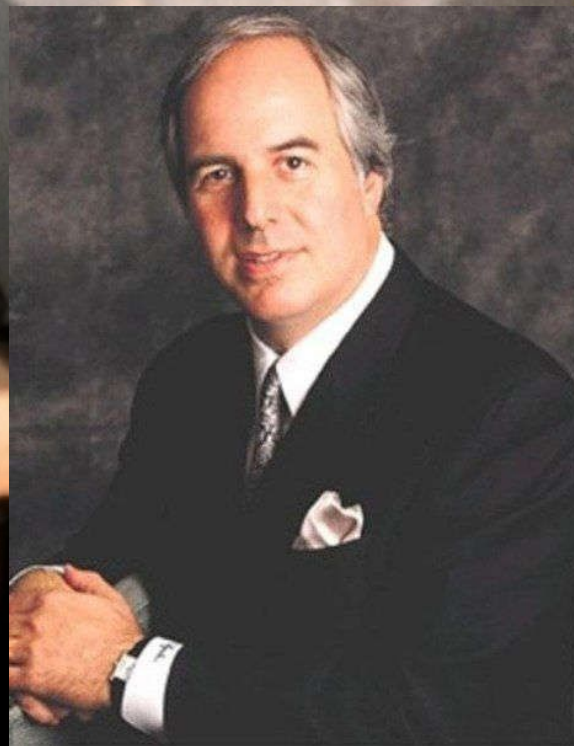
Catch me, if you can

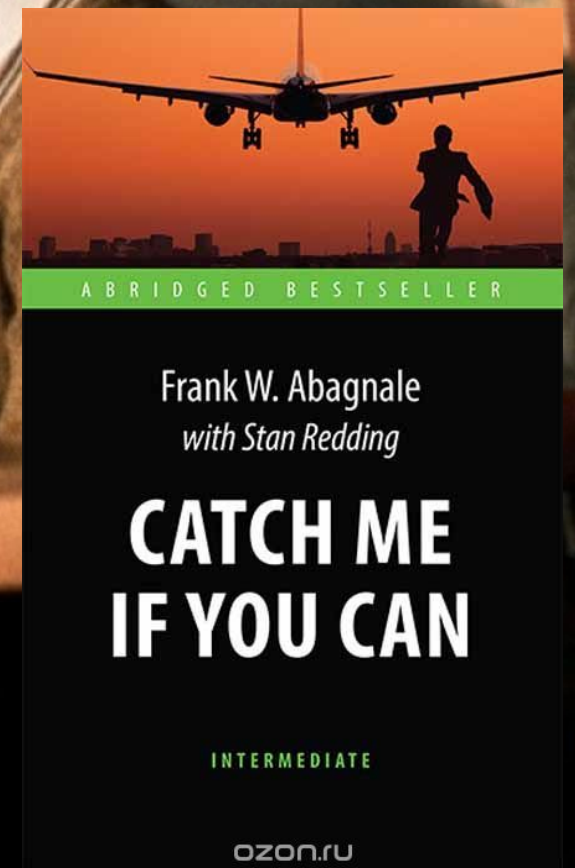

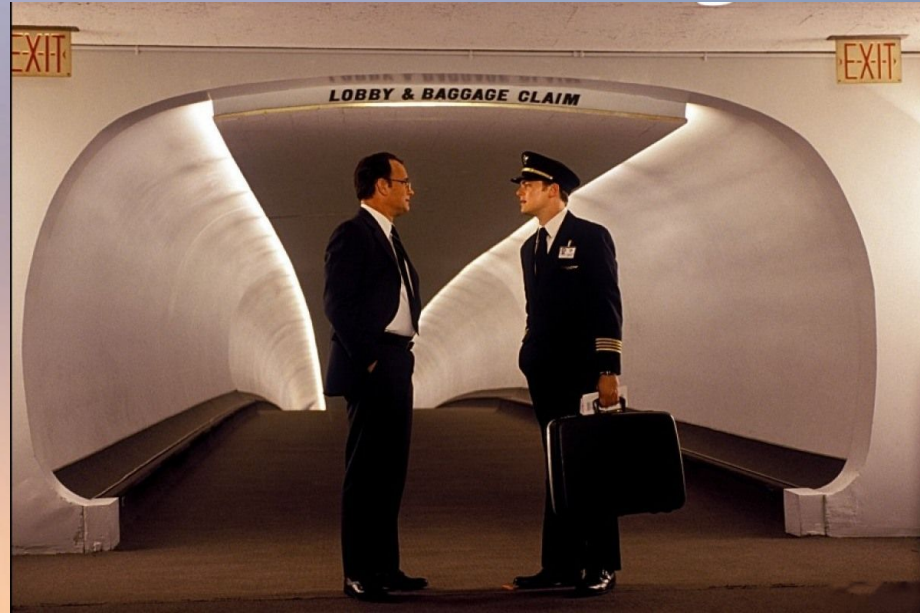
