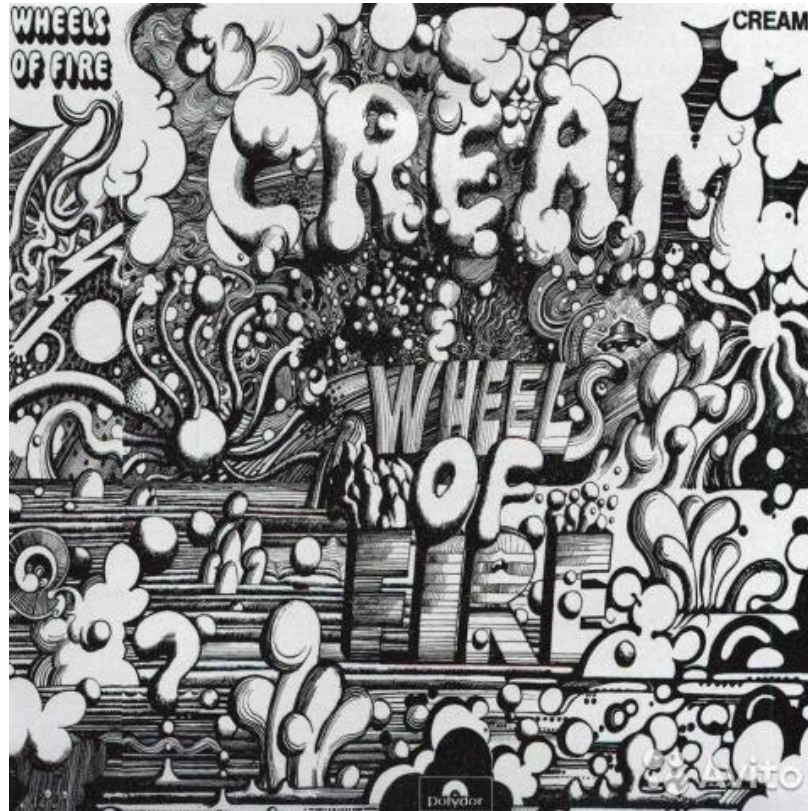
Cream (1966-1968)

- Cream is one of the most popular rock bands of era of 1960s. The band consisted of Eric Clapton, Ginger Baker and Jack Bruce.
- The band actually first decided the name “Sweet and Sour Rock and Roll” .
- Inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1993





- Wheels of Fire
- Released in 1968, Cream's third album went to #1 on the U.S. album charts and #3 in the U.K.



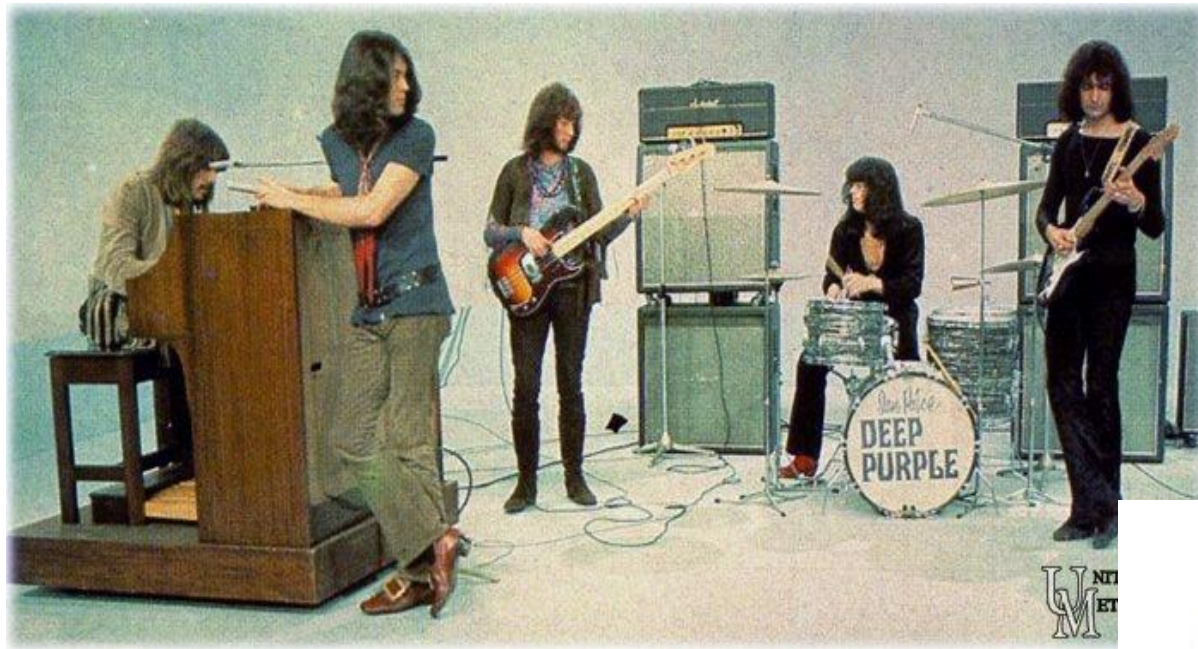
Led Zeppelin (1968-1980)

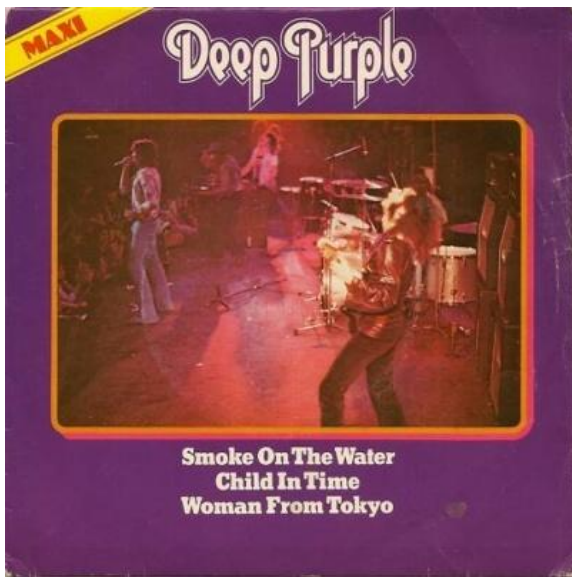
- U.S. album sales total more than 100-million.
- "Stairway To Heaven" has been played on radio more than any other song in history.
- The band received their only Grammy, a Lifetime Achievement Award in 1995.

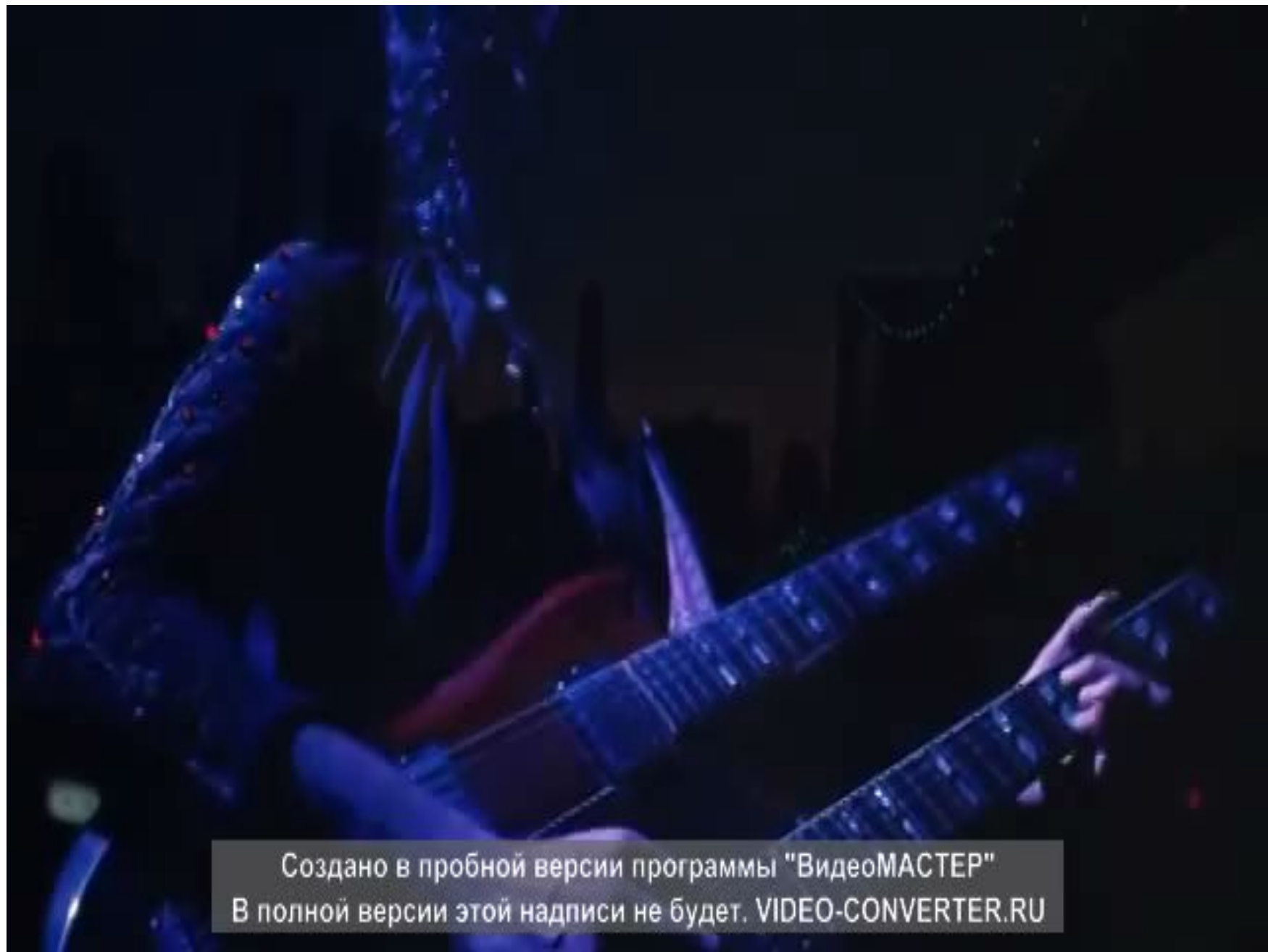


Deep Purple (1968-present)

- Over 100 million albums of the band have been sold worldwide.
- They are recognized by The Guinness Book of World Records as the world's “loudest band.”
- The best album by Deep Purple is “Machine Head” which is ranked number 233 in the overall greatest album chart with a total rank score of 8,353
