


Mahatma Gandhi

- Born October 2nd 1869
- Assassinated January 30th, 1948
- Imprisoned from 18th March, 1922 to February 1924 (2 yrs.)
- Preeminent leader of the Indian Independence movement
- Married Kasturbai Makhanji and had four children




Indian Independence

- Set up Indian congress in Natal
- Led Indian's independence in 1930s and 1940s
- Encouraged non co-operation with British rule
- Led thousands on March to the sea

Disagreement

 Communal riot between Muslims and Hindus in late 1946 at Southern Bangladesh causing India and Pakistan to be carved out of British India



Start of the controversy

- Took Indian issues in ways that cut Indians off Africans
- Indians are a little better if at all than savages or the Natives of Africa
- Indians are Africans were being herded discriminately at the hospital





Positive impacts

- One of the great leader, Martin Luther King was heavily influenced by Gandhi's philosophy of non-violence
- Political movements based on the method of non-violent civil disobedience
