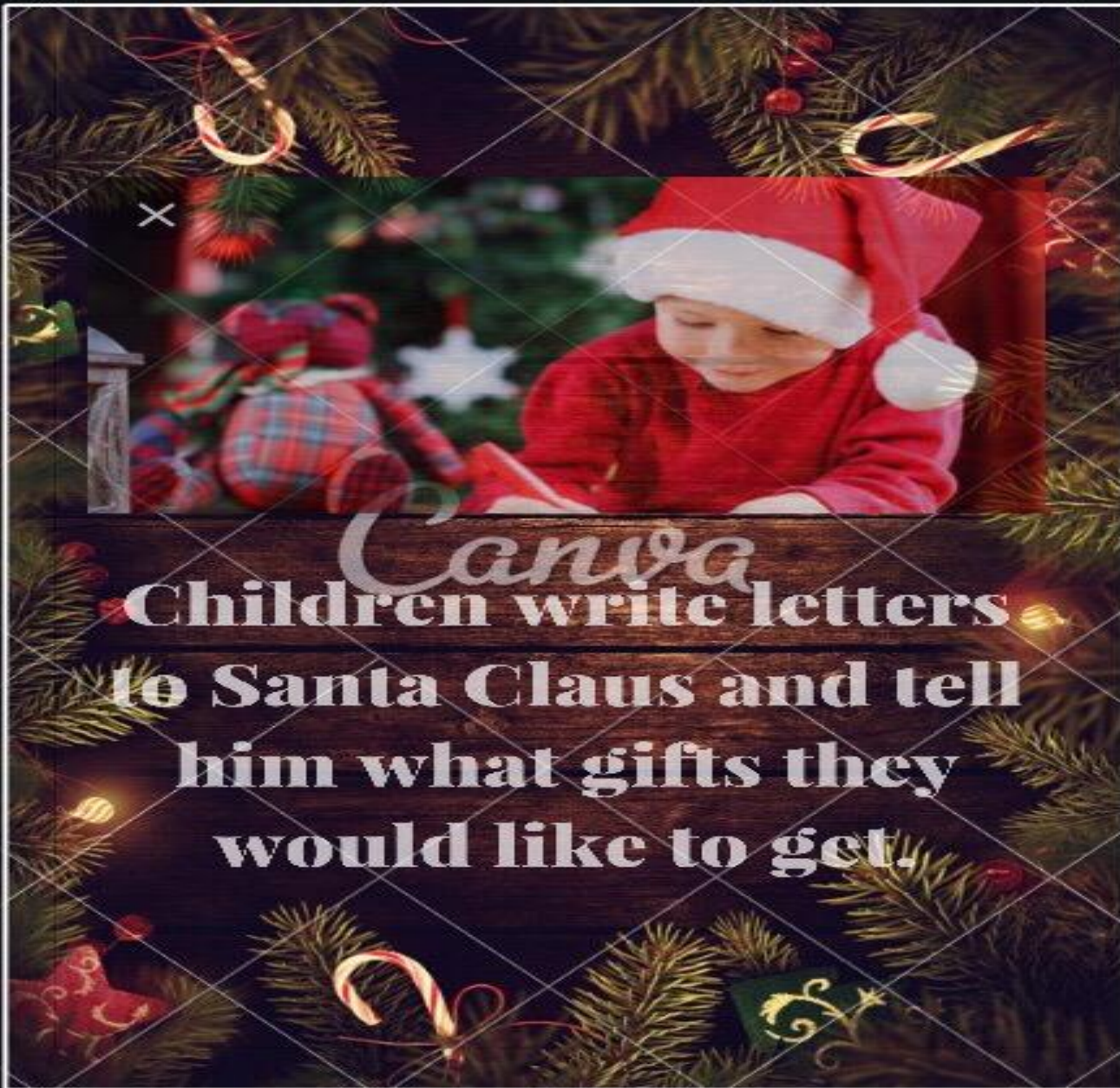




**Santa Claus North
