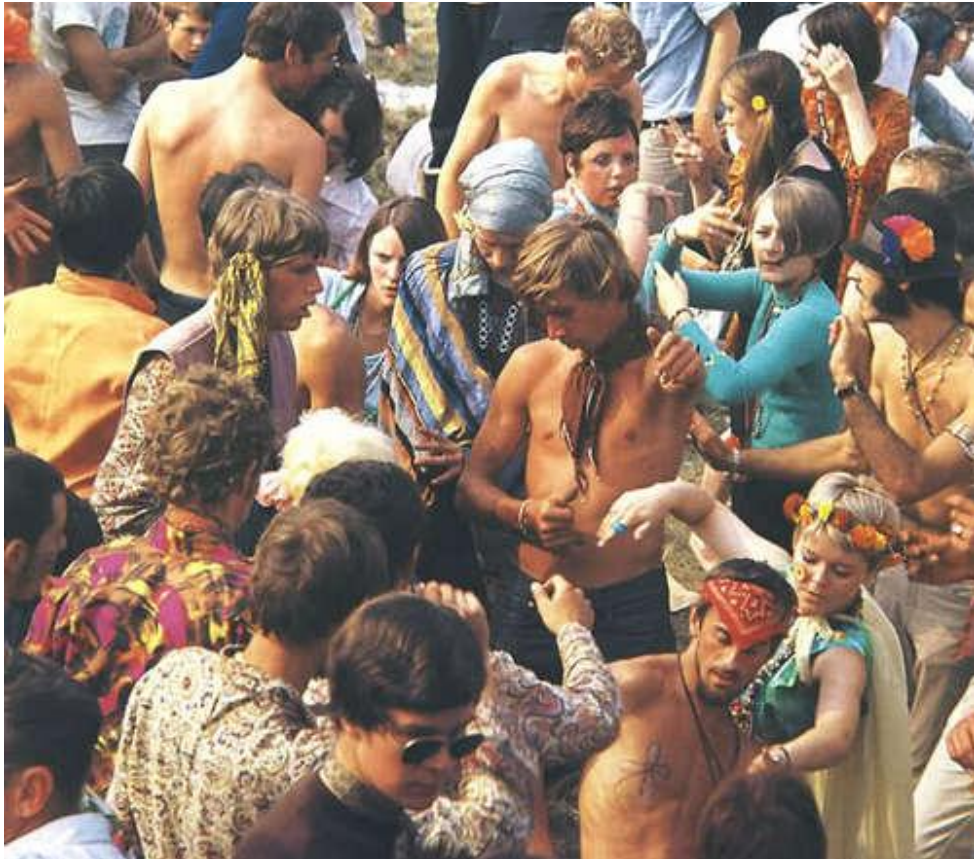


# HIPPIE subculture



The beginning of the hippie movement can be considered as 1965 in the United States



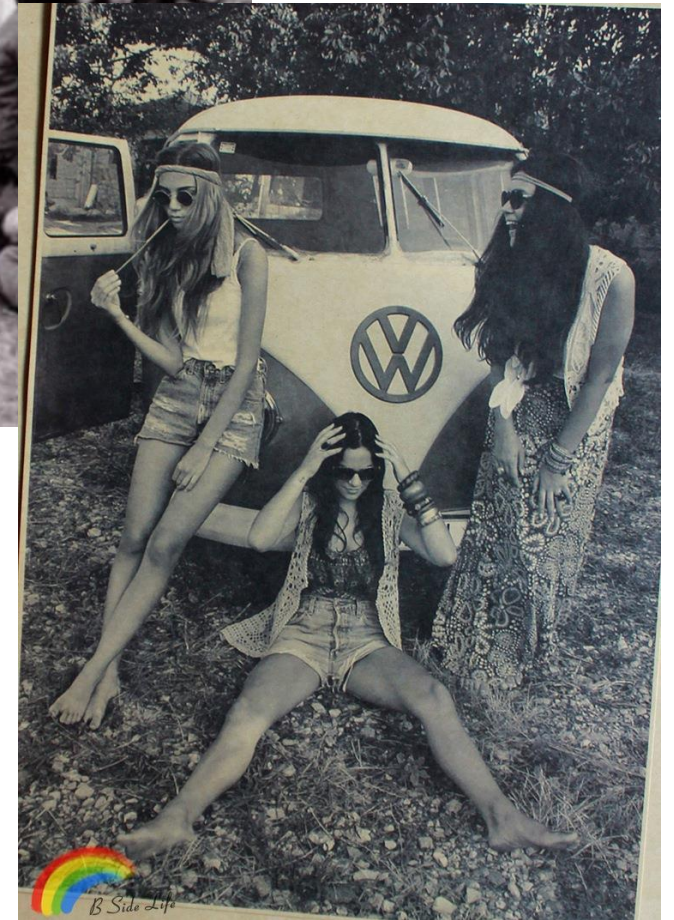
The main objective is a protest against the war with Vietnam.

Disarmament

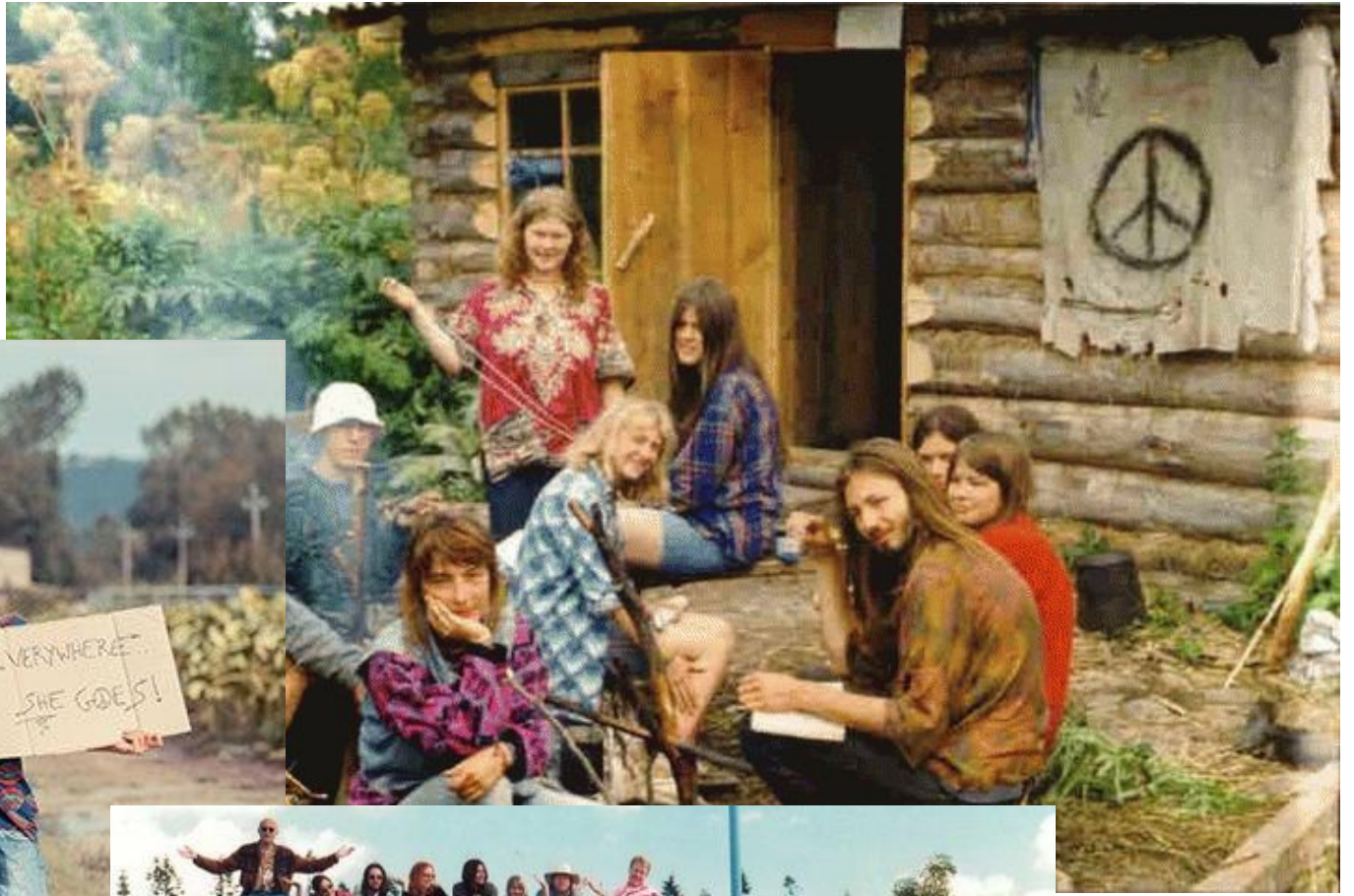




One of the typical means of movement of the hippies was considered the VW T1, which is often painted in all colors of the rainbow

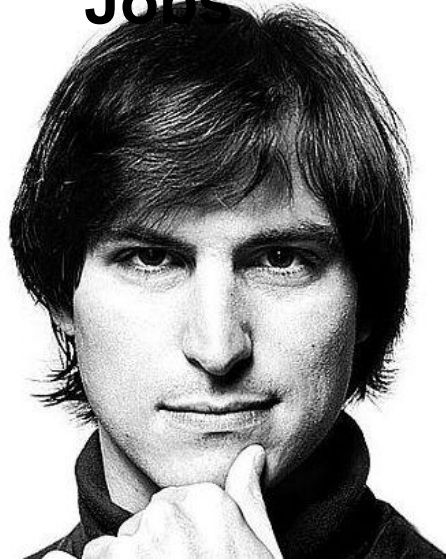

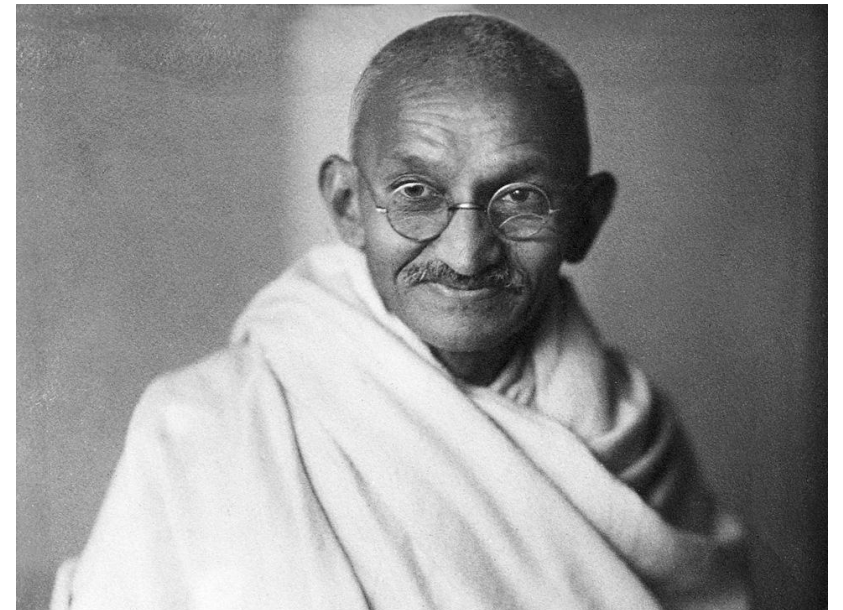
