## ABC's

• A <u>ITWAY</u>: Is there anything blocking the air from getting to the lungs from the mouth? Tilt head back gently and pull chin forward.

• Breathing : Is the person breathing? <u>Look</u> at their chest for rising, <u>Listen</u> for breathing, <u>Feel</u> for breathing with your ear.

 Circulation: is the heart pumping blood around the body?
 Check for pulse.

# First on the scene

- 1. Yell <u>Help</u>
- 2. <u>Survey</u>the <u>Scen</u>to make sure it is safe.
- 3. <u>Tapand</u> Shout to see if the victim is conscious.
- 4. Call <u>9-1</u>-1
- 5. Open Airway: Head \_\_tiphin \_\_tift
- 6. Check breathing: \_\_\_\_\_at the chest.
  - for breathing.
  - for breathing with ear
- 7. If not breathing give 2 breathes watching for the chest to rise.
- 8. Check pulse for <u>10</u> sec.
- 9. Give any care needed.
