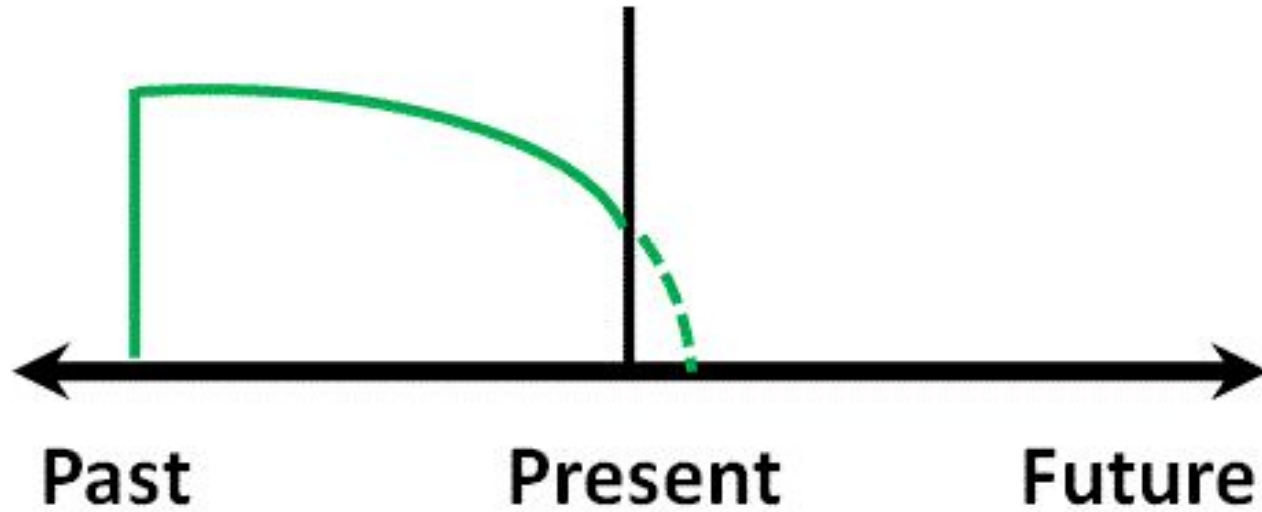


**PRESENT PERFECT

Present Perfect Continuous

(has / have) + (been) + (verb+ ing)
