Grammar

◆ Prepositions of time

- **at:** hours – at 8:00 – at night/at the weekend
- **on:** days – on Monday, dates – on 6th May
- **in:** months – in January, seasons – in autumn, years – in 1992, in the morning, in the afternoon/evening
