

The monuments to heroes of the 1st World War



The monument to heroes of World War I (Rostov-on-Don)

It is one of the monuments in the city of Rostov-on-Don, dedicated to the soldiers and officers of the Russian Imperial Army who fought in the First World War. It was erected in 2014 to commemorate a century anniversary since the start of the First World War.

The sculptor is Sergei Mikhailovich Isakov.

The monument is a 3.5-meter-high bronze figure of a soldier in a uniform with a rifle on his shoulder. It is situated in the public square at Karsnoarmeyskaya street.



The Monument to heroes of World War I (Moscow)



The decision to build a monument to the heroes of the First world war in Moscow was made in April 2013.

It was decided to install the monument on Poklonnaya Gora between the triumphal arch and the Museum of the great Patriotic war. The authors of the monument sculptors A. Kovalchuk, P. Lyubimov and V. Yusupov, and architects M. Korsi and S. Shlenkina.

Monument to heroes of World War I (Moscow)

Russian President Vladimir Putin took part in the ceremony. At the opening of the monument, the President made a speech.

"Exactly a century ago, Russia was forced to enter the First world war. And today we are opening a memorial to its heroes — Russian soldiers and officers. Open on Poklonnaya hill, which keeps a grateful memory of the military glory of the Russian army. About all those who at different stages of the history of the Russian state defended its independence, dignity and freedom," — said Vladimir Putin.



The Monument to heroes of World War I (Pskov)

The monument to the heroes of the First World War the works of the People's Artist of Russia Salavat Shcherbakov is installed in Pskov by the Russian military historical society in the centenary year of the First World War. He is a figure of Russian soldier going to attack with a rifle. Behind it is developing a banner of the Pskov Regiment depicting the Virgin and the coat of arms of Russia.
