


History of the town









In 1863 it was included in the Oblast of the Don army, that was the impetus for the further development.


By the decree of Alexander I of August 17, 1807, the fortress received the status of a district town.

The First World War, the events of October 1917 and the Civil War radically changed the life of Rostov






The Great Patriotic War of 1941-45 inflicted terrible wounds on the city




