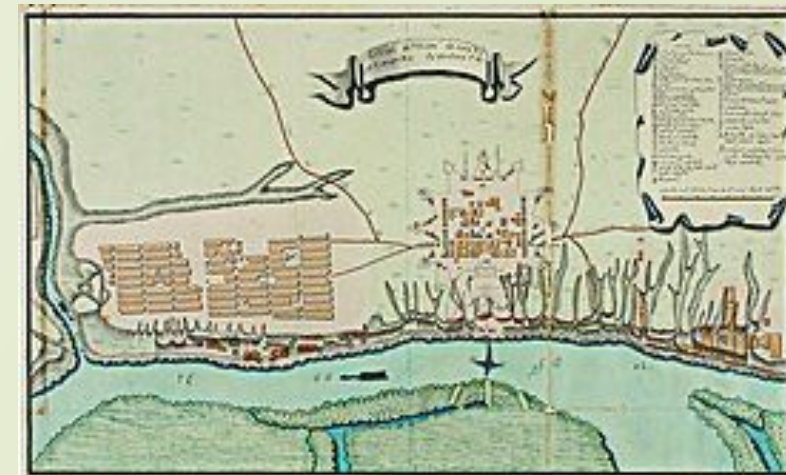

# History of the town

- The history of Rostov-on-Don dates back to the founding of Temernitskaya customs in 1749. Later, a fortress was built, named in honor of St. Dmitry of Rostov.

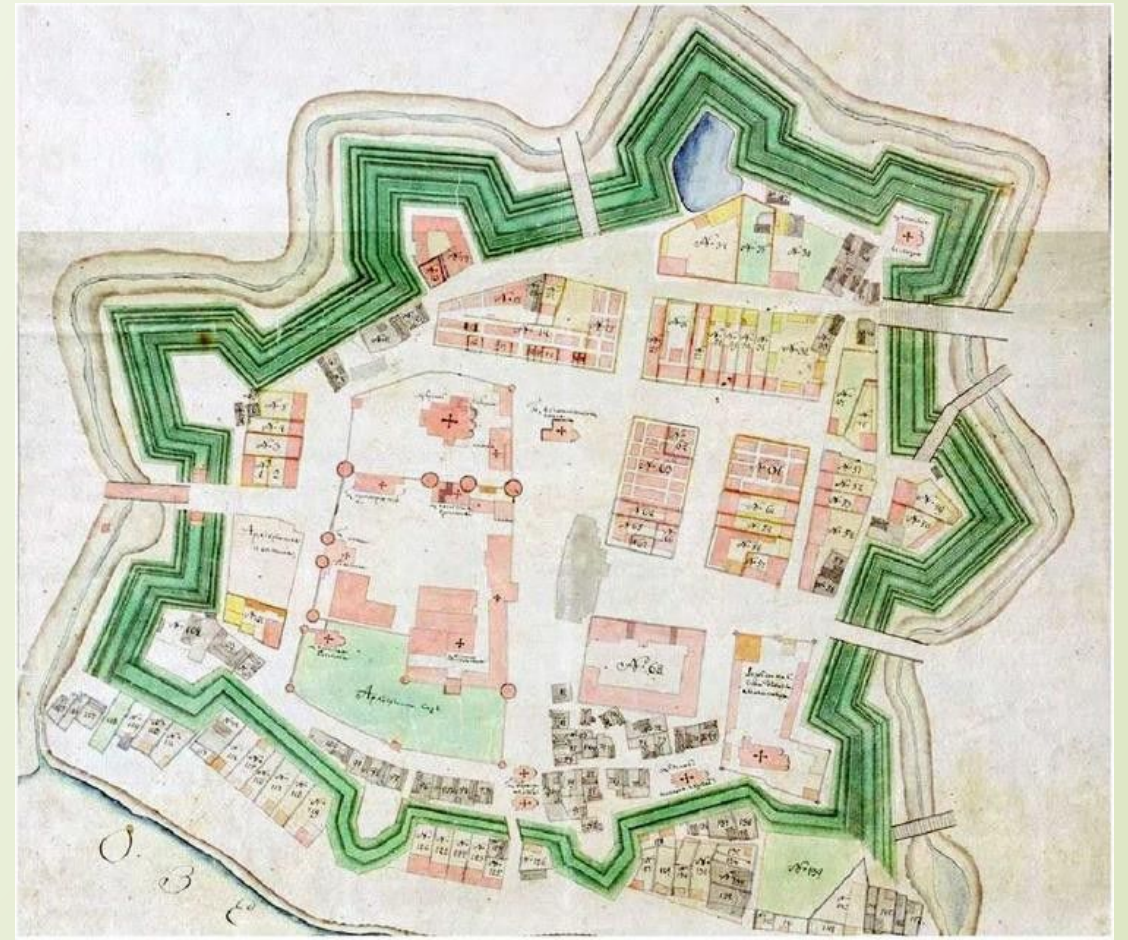




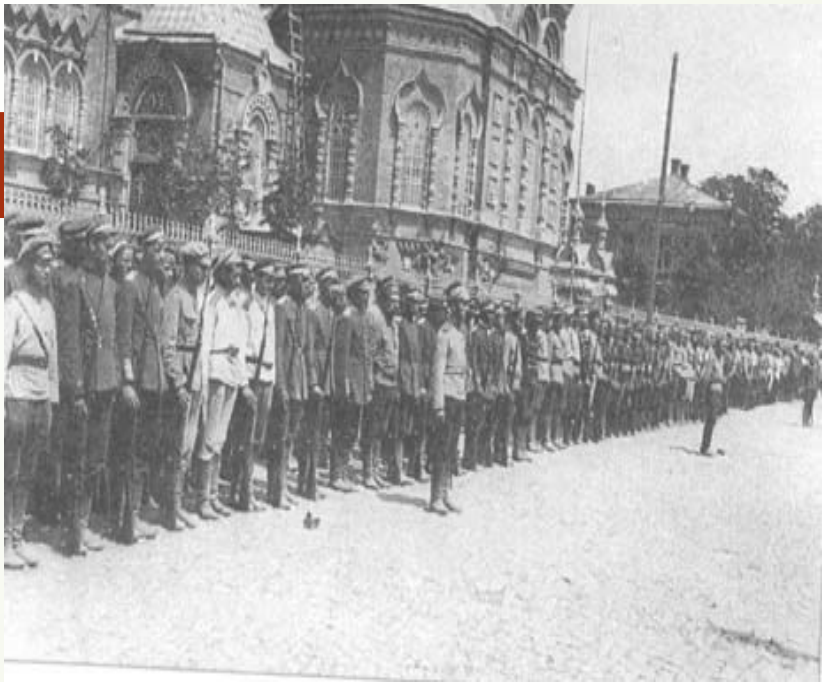


- In 1863 it was included in the Oblast of the Don army, that was the impetus for the further development.

- By the decree of Alexander I of August 17, 1807, the fortress received the status of a district town.







Only in 1920 the city slowly began to restore its economy.



- The First World War, the events of October 1917 and the Civil War radically changed the life of Rostov





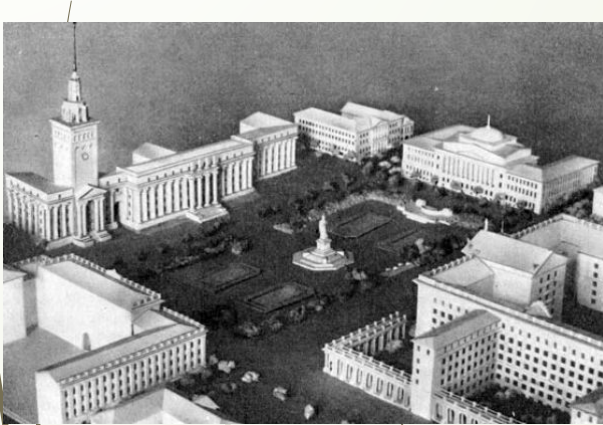


□ The Great Patriotic War of 1941-45 inflicted terrible wounds on the city

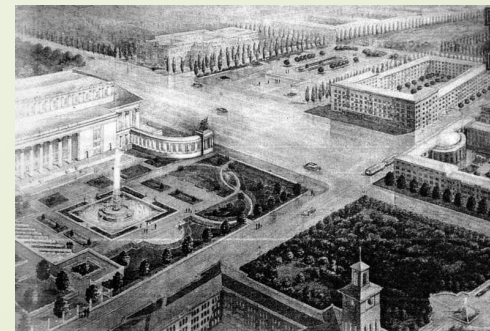
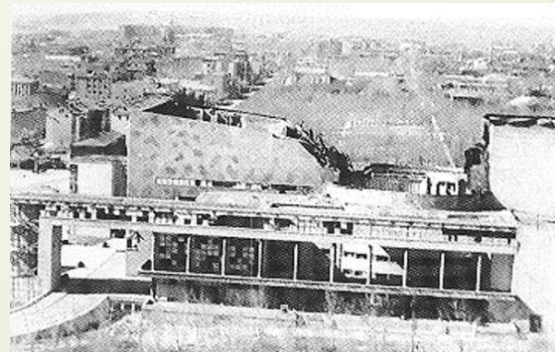

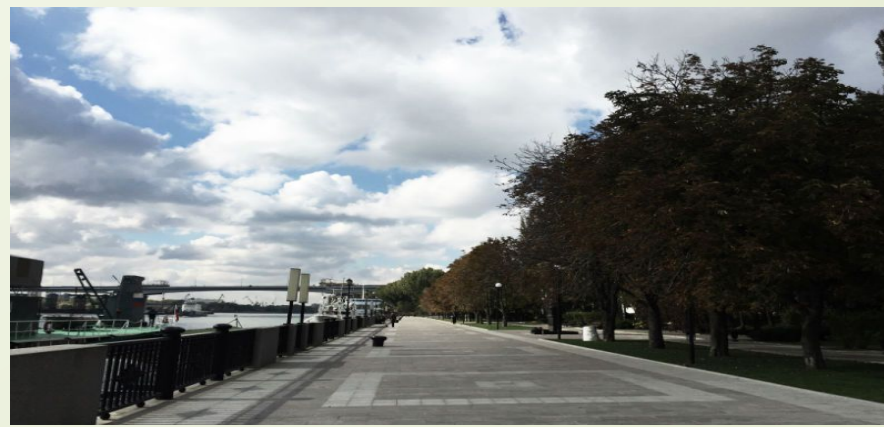

□ In Rostov-on-Don today there are more than 800 objects of cultural heritage.



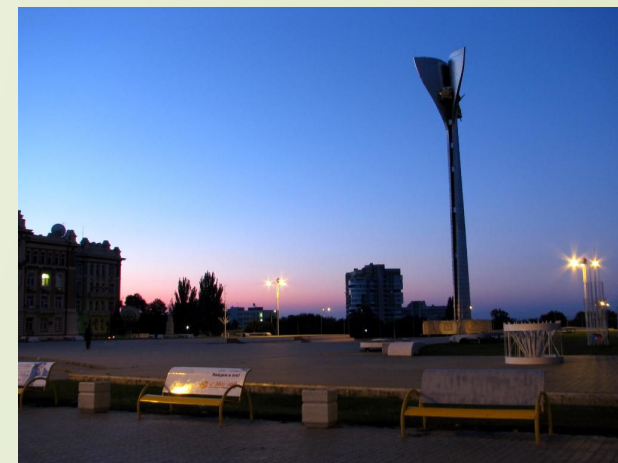
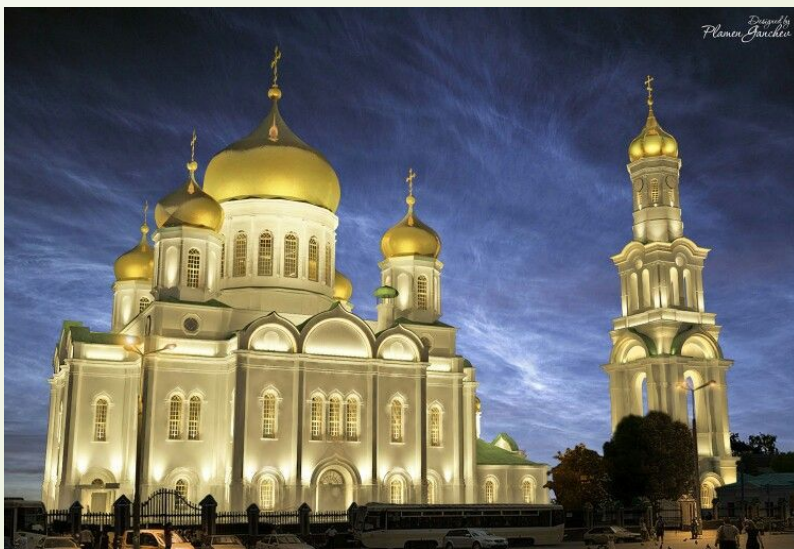
