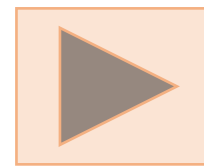

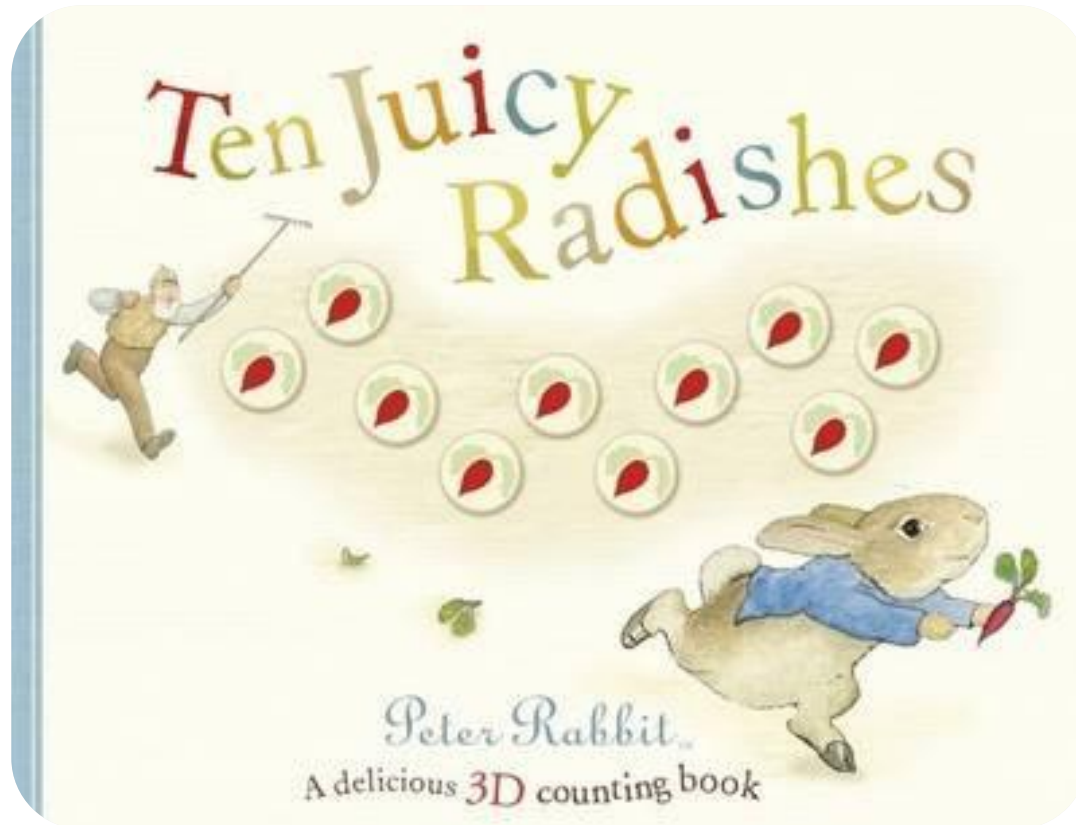

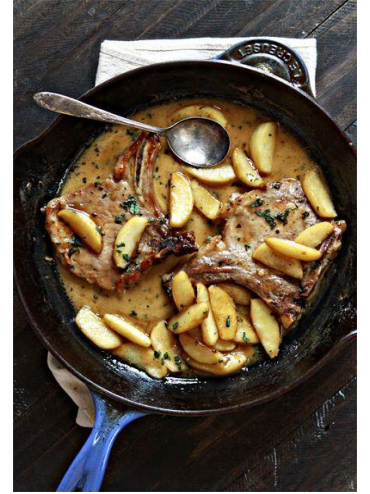
Samhain Cooking Traditions
