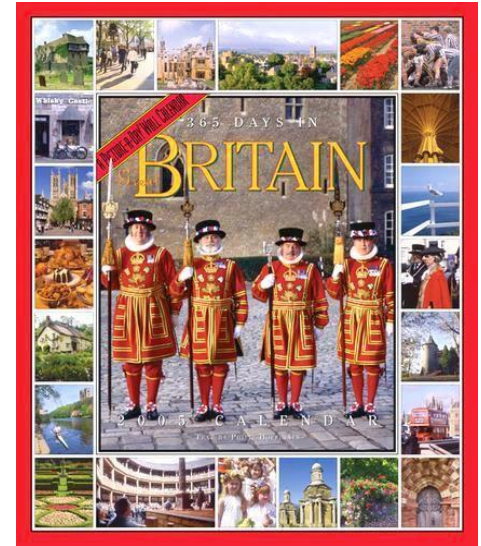


USEFUL INFORMATION
