

# What should I do?





- You should do something = it is a good thing to do, it is the right thing to do:
  - □ Tom doesn't study enough. He should study harder.
  - ☐ It's a good film. You should go and see it.
  - □ When you play tennis, you should always watch the ball.
- You shouldn't do something = it is not a good thing to do.
- Shouldn't = should not:
  - □ Tom shouldn't go to bed so late.
  - ☐ You watch TV all the time. You shouldn't watch TV so much.

# Must is stronger than should:

- ☐ It's a good film. You should go and see it.
- ☐ It's a fantastic film. You must go and see it.

### Another way to say should is ought to:

- ☐ It's a good film. You ought to go and see it. (= you should go)
- □ I think Lisa ought to buy some new clothes. (= Lisa should buy)



We often say I think ... should ...

#### I think ... should ...:

- □ I think Lisa should buy some new clothes.
  - (= I think it is a good idea.)
- ☐ It's late. I think I should go home now.
- ☐ A: Shall I buy this coat?
  - B: Yes, I think you should.

#### I don't think ... should ... :

- □ I don't think you should work so hard.
  - (= I don't think it is a good idea.)
- □ I don't think we should go yet. It's too early.
