10 PLACES IN MOSCOW TO WISIT

RED SQUAR

At the Red Square you can see the Lenin Mausoleum, the monument to Minin and Pozharskiy, the Lobnoye Place, tsar orders were read from it.



ST. BASIL'S CATHEDRAL

It's a Russian Orthodox church erected on the Red Square in Moscow in 1555–61. It was built on the order of Ivan the Terrible to commemorate the capture of Kazan and Astrakhan. It was the tallest building in Moscow until the completion of the Ivan the Great Bell Tower in 1600.



THE SPARROW HILLS CABELWAY



It's one of the most beautifull places of Moscow.



It's air transport. It connects the observation deck on the Sparrow hills with the Luzhniki stadium over the Moscow river.

OSTANKINO TOWER



Ostankino Tower Is the tallest tower in Europe and the 4th tallest building in the world. It was built in Moscow in 1967. Besides technical services, there is a sightseeing platform and a three-level restaurant «The Seventh Sky».

THE BOLSHOI THEATRE



The Bolshoi Theatre was built in 1824. It was the second biggest theatre in the world. The theatre is the parent company of The Bolshoi Ballet Academy, a world-leading school of ballet.

THE TRETYAKOV GALLERY



This gallery was founded by Russian merchant Pavel / Tretyakov in 1856. It has a large collection of wonderful works of art.

\mathbf{VDNH}

The name of this historic site is a Soviet abbreviation which stands for the "Exhibition of Achievements of National Economy". For many years, this exhibition center showcased various products, and innovations brought here from every corner of the USSR and then Russia.




THE MOSCOW ZOO
