
Branches of Ayurveda according to Charaka Samhita

- The Charaka Club was started in 1898, founded by four doctors- Charles. L.
 Dana, Joseph Colleirs, Fedrick Petterson and Barnad Sachs.
- It was in the eighth meeting of the club that the name Charaka was adopted for the club when in a paper presented by Barnard Sachs- it was mentioned that Charaka was one of the oldest scholar associated with medicine.
