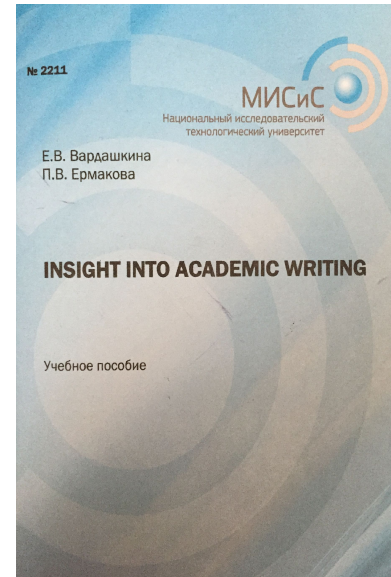
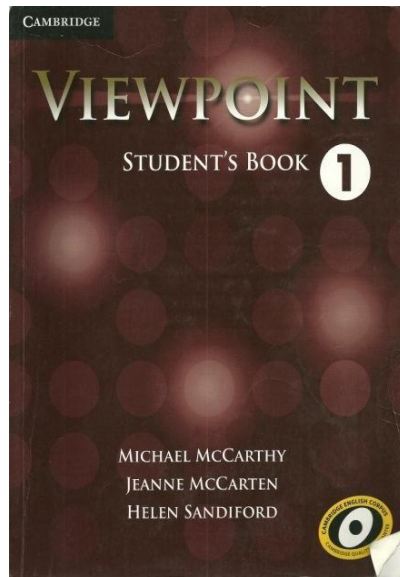

# Reading

<p><b>Section 1</b></p>	<p><i>The passage usually contains <b>arguments and opinions</b> and is often <b>research-based</b>. It is generally more challenging than the other two sections.</i></p>
<p><b>Section 2</b></p>	<p><i>The text <b>is usually divided into paragraphs or sections –A,B,C, etc.</b> It may be descriptive, discursive or a combination of two. There are usually three “matching tasks” –matching headings or information.</i></p>
<p><b>Section 3</b></p>	<p><i>The passage is usually <b>descriptive or factual</b>. A candidate needs to find specific information. It is the easiest part.</i></p>

# Speaking

<b>Part 1</b>	<b><i>After a minute's preparation, the candidate speaks for two minutes on a familiar topic provided by the examiner. 3-4 min</i></b>
<b>Part 2</b>	<b><i>The examiner and the candidate discuss some general questions based on the theme of the previous topic. 4-5 min</i></b>
<b>Part 3</b>	<b><i>The examiner asks a number of questions about familiar topic such as studies, hobbies, etc. 4-5 min</i></b>

# Writing

Task 1	A 150-word summary of information presented in graphic or diagrammatic form. Candidates are advised to spend 20 min on Task 1.
Task 2	a 250-word essay presenting an argument on a given topic. Candidates are advised to spend 40 min on Task 2.
