

BILL OFTEN **TAKES**
(TAKE) HIS DOG TO THE PARK.

PRESENT SIMPLE

to express :

□ repeated actions – **I play tennis.**

□ facts or generalizations – **Cats like milk.**

□ scheduled events in the future –
The film starts at 8.

□ state verbs (non-continuous verbs) – **She needs help.**

FORM: verb + s or es in third person

I play tennis every Saturday.

She often watches television.

He speaks English.

Do or does + base form for questions:

Do you like chocolate?

Does she speak Italian?

Don't or doesn't + base form for negatives:

They don't live in London.

He doesn't drink tea.

Adverb placement

The examples below show the placement for adverbs such as:

always, never, often, sometimes, rarely, ever, still, just, only, etc.

Before the verb:

You only speak English.

Do you still live in London?

After the verb to be:

I'm never late.

He's often busy.

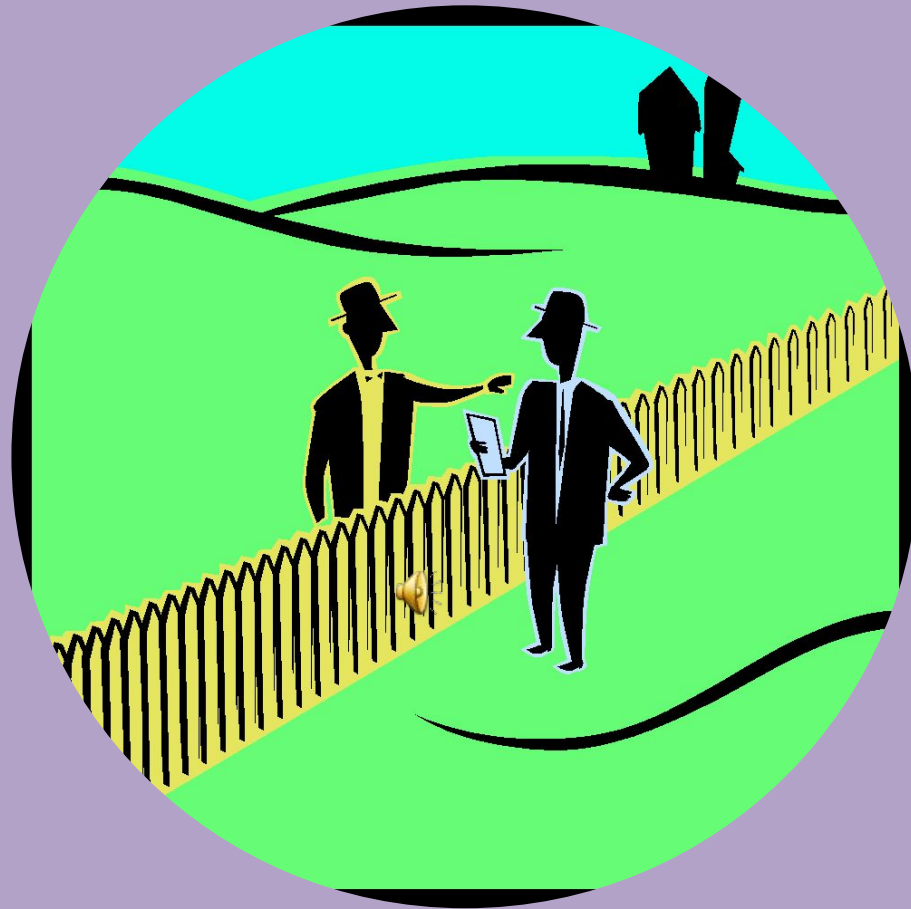
