The Point Reyes Lighthouse



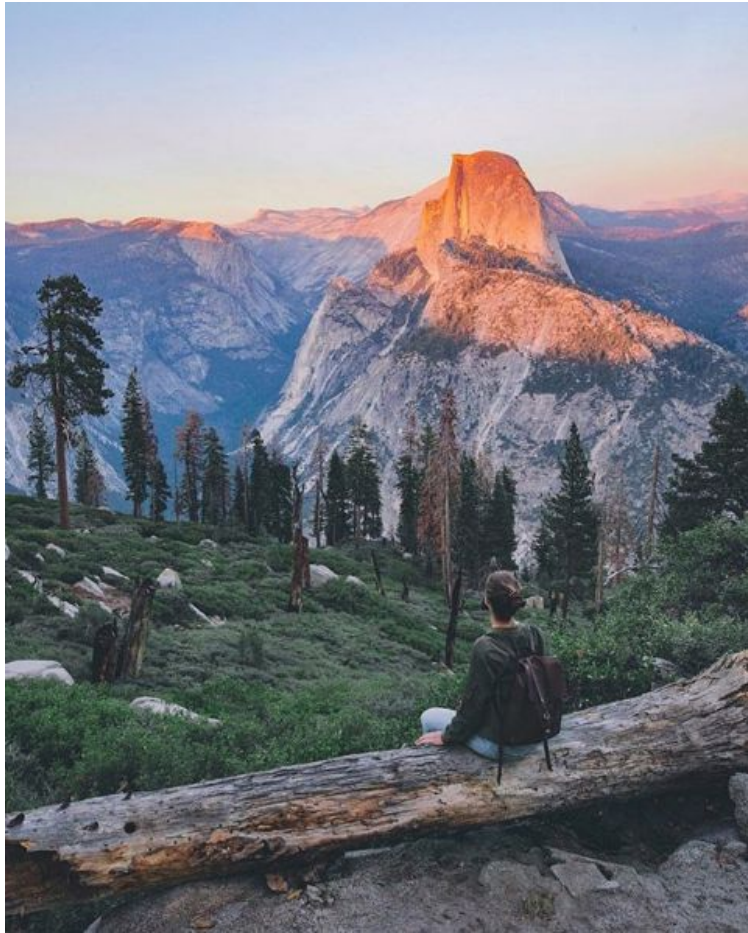

The Grand Canyon



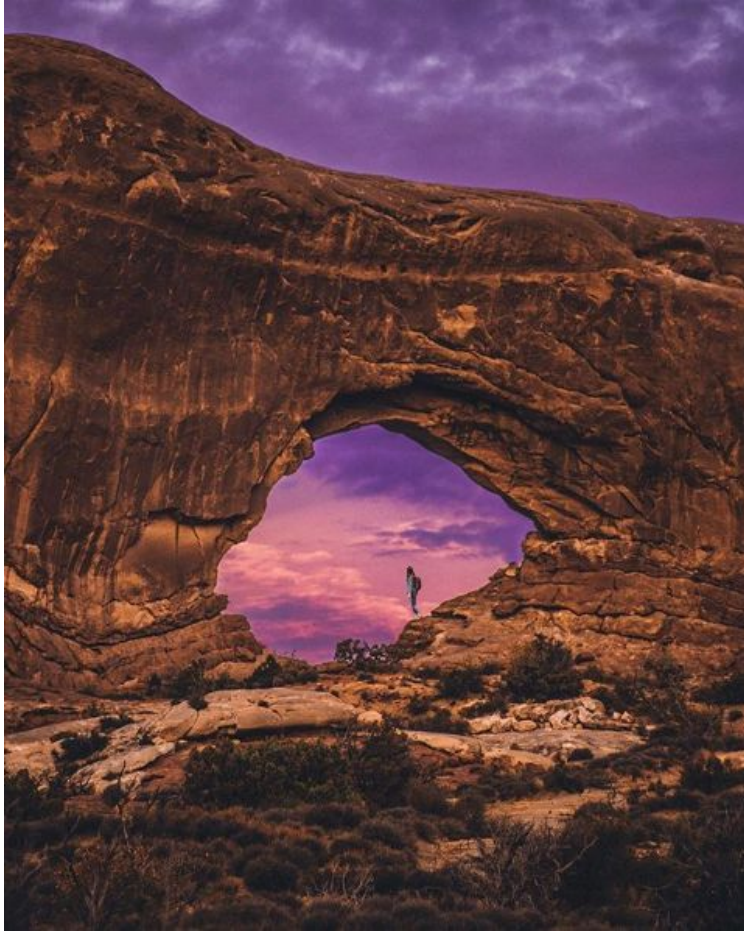
