

About the creator

Walt Disney (1901-1966)

Walter Elias "Walt" Disney was an American entrepreneur, animator, voice actor and film producer. A pioneer of the American animation industry, he introduced several developments in the production of cartoons.







About the studio

Walt Disney Animation Studios(1923), headquartered at the Walt Disney Studios in California, is an American animation studio that creates animated feature films, short films, and television specials for The Walt Disney Company. The studio has produced 56 feature films, from Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs (1937) to Moana (2016).



achievements

Walt Disney Animation Studio is notable for its innovations, which have become standards in the animation industry:


- The first big film with a stereo sound ("Fantasy")
- Drawing animated film with the biggest box office all the time ("The Lion King" and then "Frozen").
- Realistic animation of special effects and human characters ("Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs")
- combined games of actors and animated elements on color film ("Three Caballeros")
- Introduction of digital technologies in the creation of cartoons, using it in coloring, imposition of images and sound recording. (Computer Animation Production System, abbreviated CAPS).



Steamboat Willie is especially notable for being the first Disney and world cartoon with <u>synchronized sound</u>, including character sounds and a musical score.

The first animated film using Technicolor (system of making colourful animated films). ("Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs")

Using Multiple camera which is used to create a complex animation using alternating layers, "awarded" Oscar ", then in" Snow White and Seven Dwarfs "),









The first cartoon, shot using only digital technologies ("Rescuers in Australia", where for the first time was using CAPS)




 using the photocopying animation to translate the drawings to celluloid (designed to create the cartoon "101 Dalmatians", awarded the Oscar)

2. Decision-making about technique.



6. After making a screenplay and before drawing











7. Then the artists paint the backgrounds and then combine all the frames and paint them in separate

layers.

















Disney's legends
