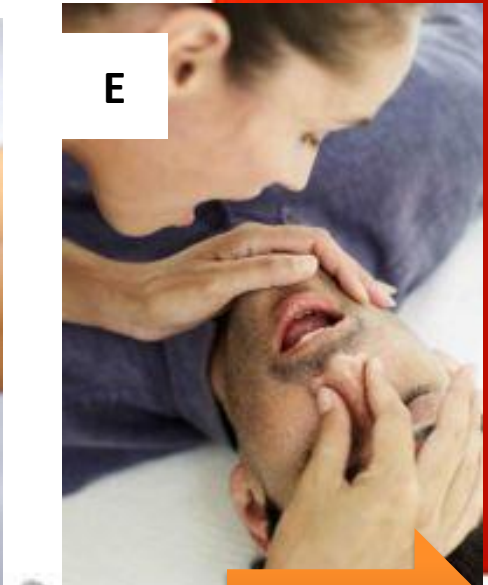

Problem 1

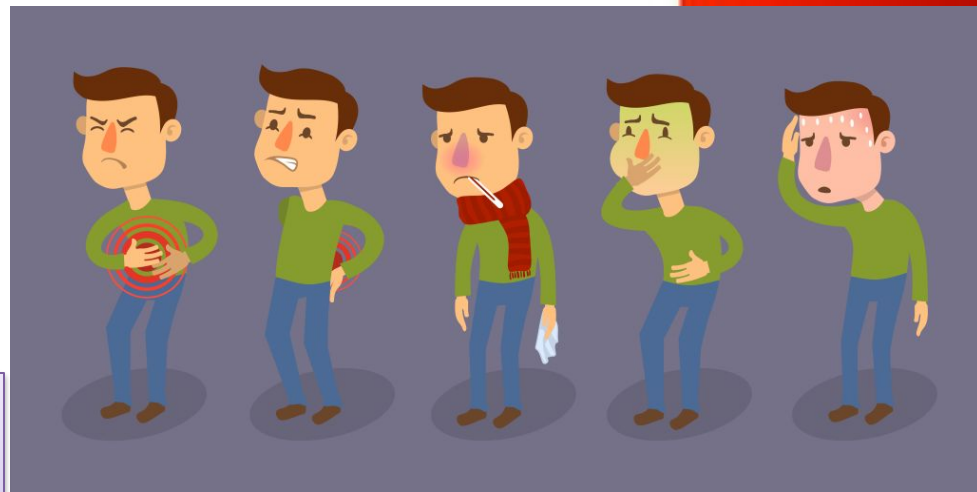
Problem 5

If you help a person who is *in shock*:

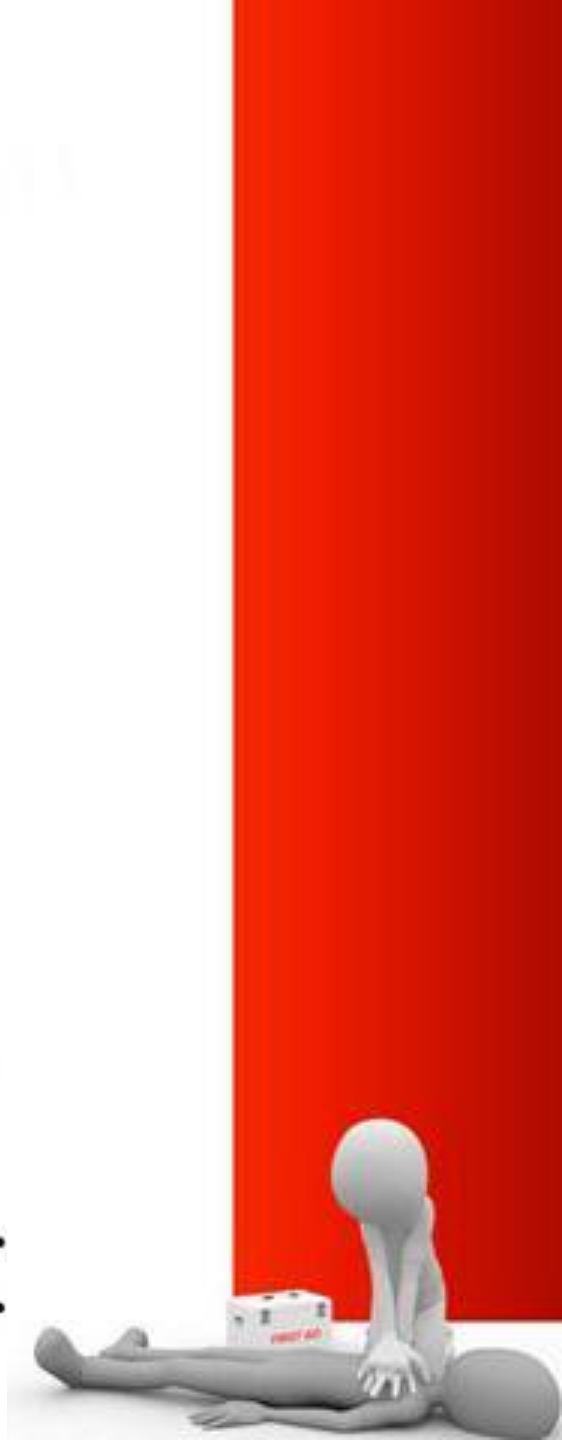
1. Lay the person flat on the back.

If you help a person with *poisoning*:

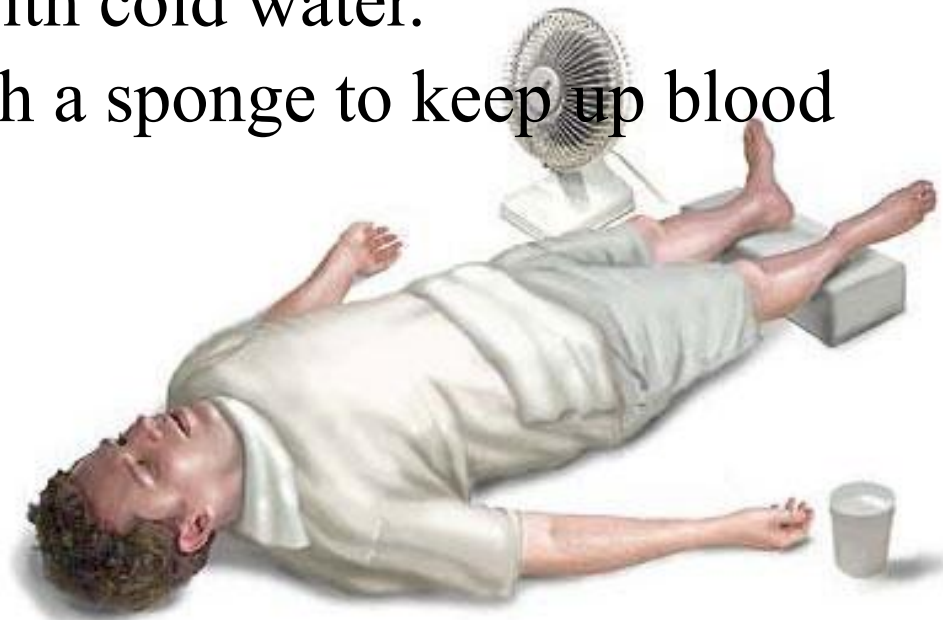
1. Give him much water to drink.

3. Take the patient into a cool and shady place.
4. Raise his head and shoulders a little.
5. Cool his body with cold water.
6. Rub his skin with a sponge to keep up blood circulation.

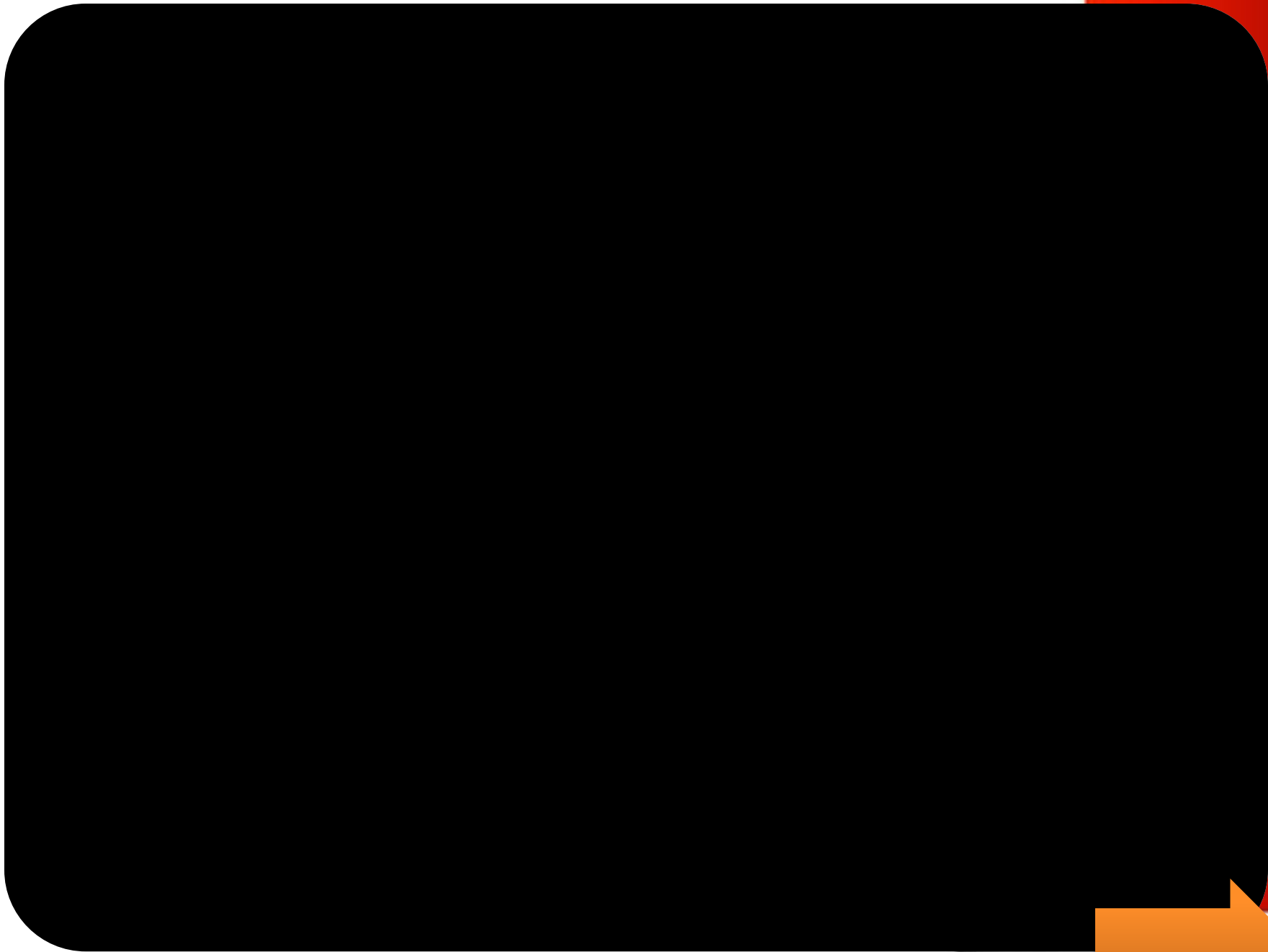

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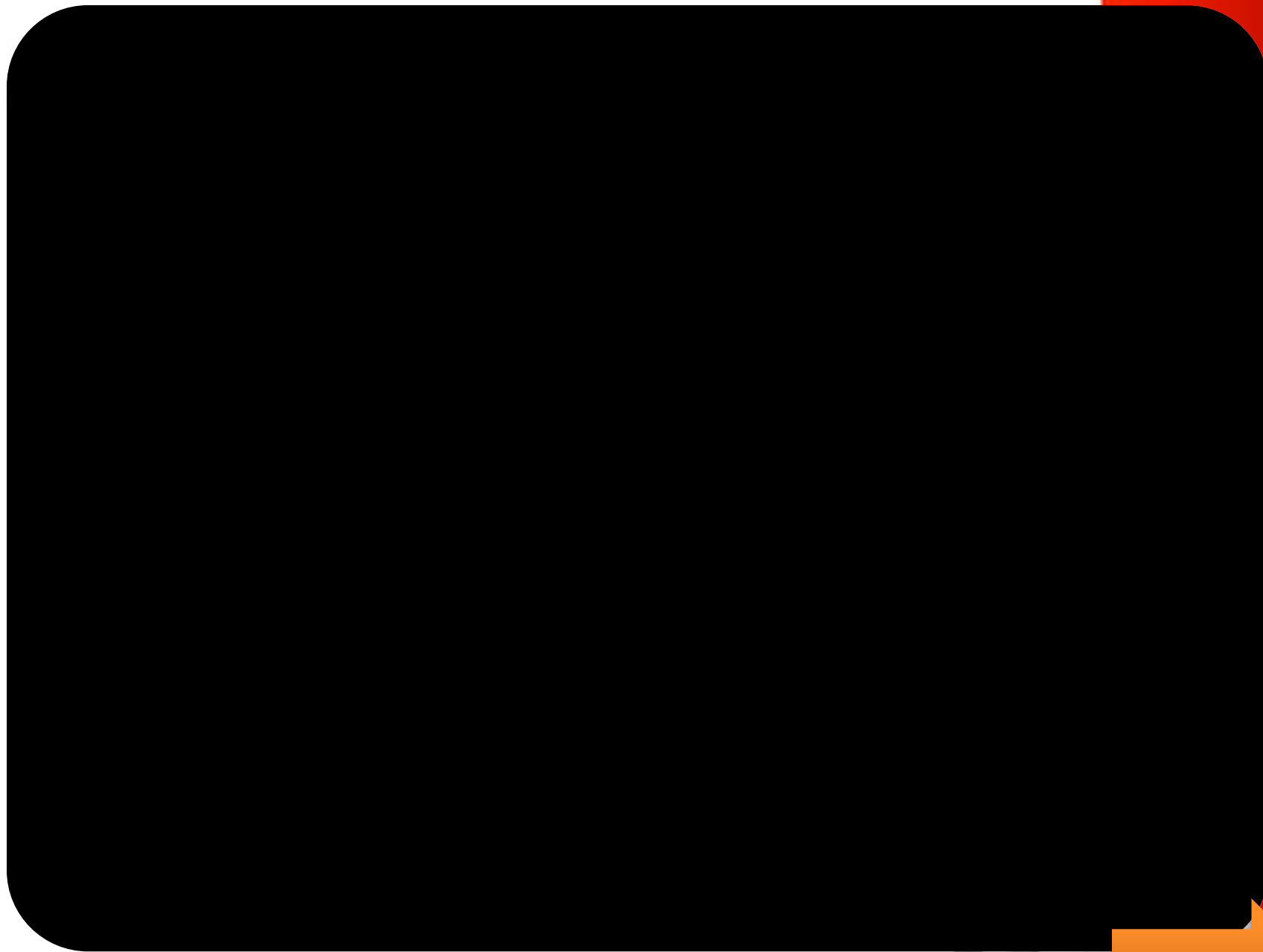
