- General ability (past)
- Permission (formal)
- Request (polite)
- □ I could swim when I was 5.
- □ Could you help me?
- ☐ We **couldn't** run at school.

OBLIGATION

MUST TO

обязательство

about yourself and to your children

обязательство перед собой

MUSTN'T = HEALBIR

- **must** go to work.
- mustn't do this.

obligation in general, rule

HAVE TO

обязанность в целом, правило

NOT HAVE TO = не надо

- You have to go to work.
- don't have to do the homework today.



- Ask how to get to the metro






