







Definition of Terrorism

Terrorism is politically motivated violence directed against noncombatants and designed to instill fear in a target audience. Terrorism has been used throughout history and is shocking in its very nature.

CAUSES OF TERRORISM
□ Social and political injustice
☐ The belief that violence or its threat will be effective (Many terrorists in history said sincerely that they choose violence after long deliberation, because they felt they had no choice.)
$\square Religious$ (Though it is not the main cause for terrorism, religion does play a significant role in driving some forms of it. Many terrorist get wrong understanding in religion).
□ Illiteracy (. Uneducated person are easy to be persuaded to commit the crime because they have no high ability of thinking. Many terrorists believe crazy things; they're more likely to do crazy things.
□ Injustice (m. People get offended and hurt by the justice system that they choose to recent to acts of violence in order to protest the on- going injustice

SOLUTIONS TO TERRORISM

- 1. Education!!! Understand the differences in cultures, religions, beliefs and human behaviors Think of the peace, freedom and equality of all human beings, not just "one group of people" Eliminate the root of terrorism
- 2. Education: education is a primary solution to terrorism. The government should educate the people to understand the differences in culture, religion, belief, and human behaviors. All people should think of the peace, freedom and equality of all human beings, not just "their group of people"
- 3. Eliminate the root of terrorism: The way this world is attacking terrorism is funny. Every country is doing something to kill terrorism, but they still cannot eliminate all terrorist. They can kill some terrorists today, but they cannot kill the other terrorist tomorrow or after tomorrow. They should try to find the root of terrorism, and they have to eliminate it. Black money is the main root cause of terrorism because terrorists can do nothing without money, so the government should find who support the terrorist.
- 4. Understand about terrorists: the solution is to find out the problem why a terrorist doesn't feel guilty and why he was forced to be a terrorist. It may be some injustice done to him. Hatred spreads hatred only. It may be conquered by love only.

- 2),, Counterattacks.
- † This is appealing because it appears that punishment and justice are achieved. † Problems with counterattacks include easily identifying terrorists groups. †

When identified and attacked, such groups could respond with greater levels of terrorism.

3)Imposing the rule of law through international cooperation. † Increased cooperation between states has led to an increase in extraditions and punishments.

FIGURE 2 TERRORIST ATTACKS, 2000-2014

The majority of terrorist incidents are highly centralised. In 2014, 57 per cent of all attacks occurred in five countries; Iraq, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Nigeria and Syria. However the rest of the world suffered a 54 per cent increase in terrorist incidents in 2013.
