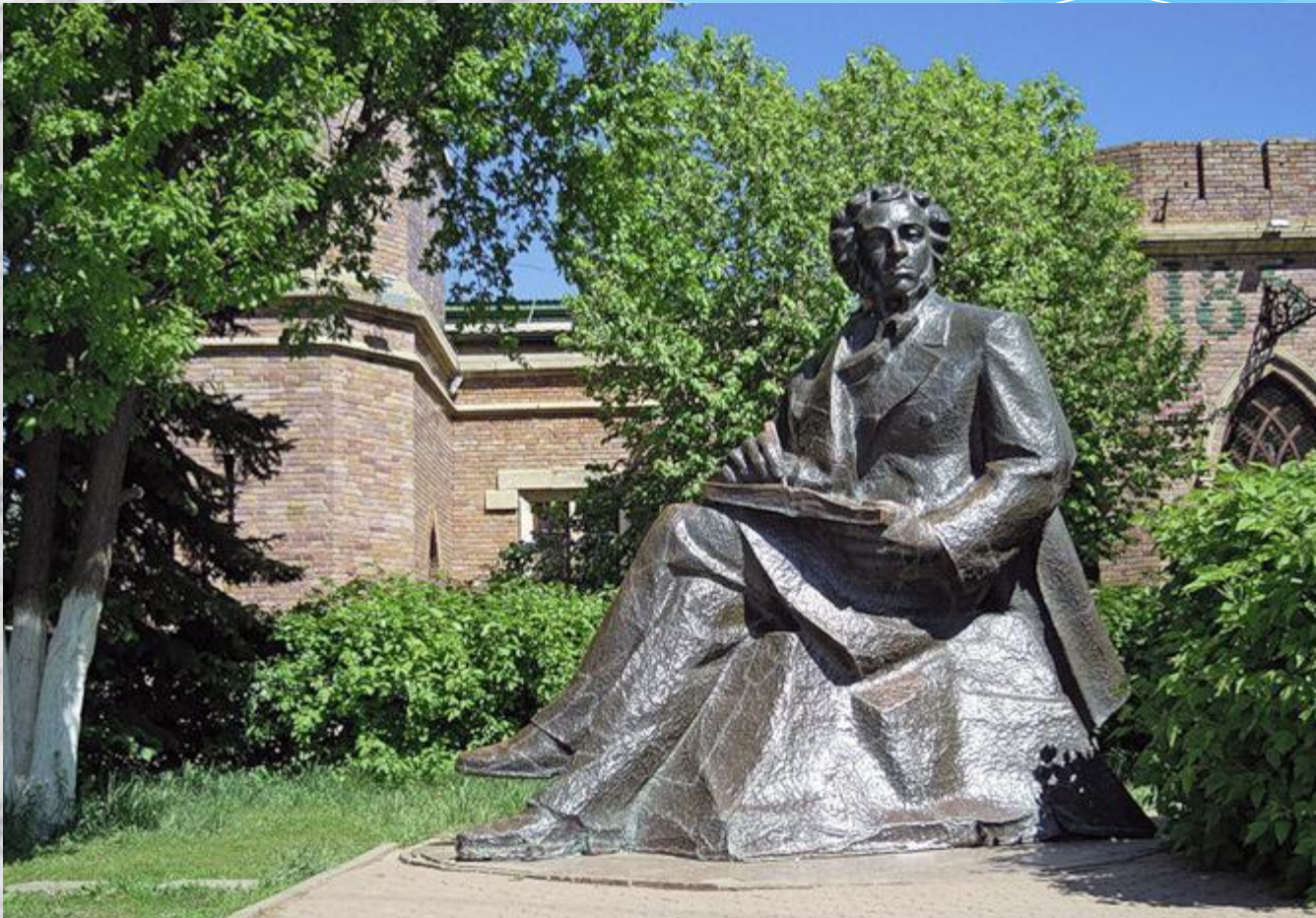
Pushkin is still in Moscow



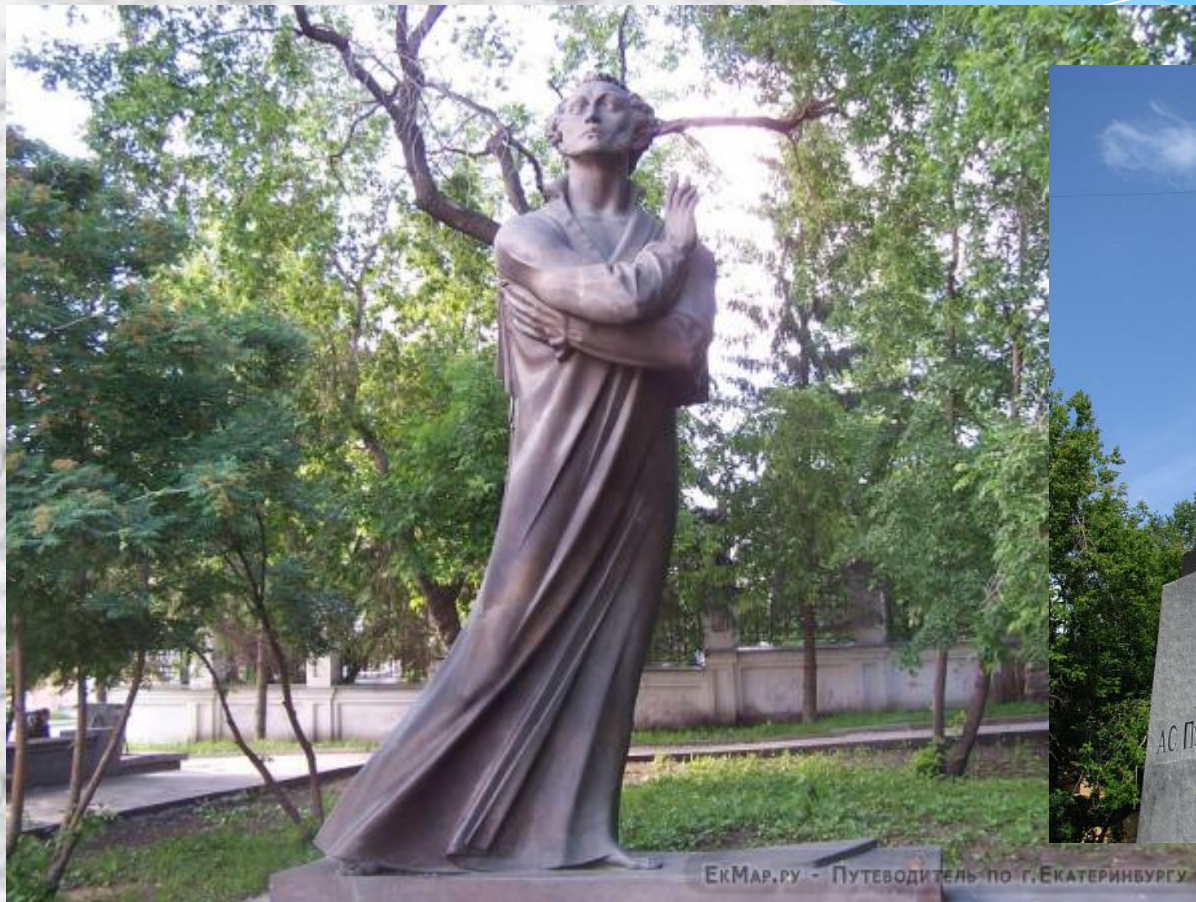
His monuments are in St. Petersburg

Monuments to Pushkin and Characters of his works in Tobolsk




Pushkin's monument in Ussuriysk
