

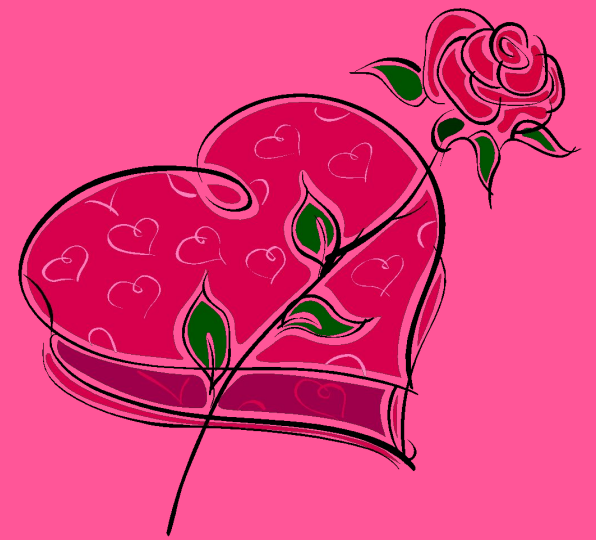
# VALENTINE'S DAY



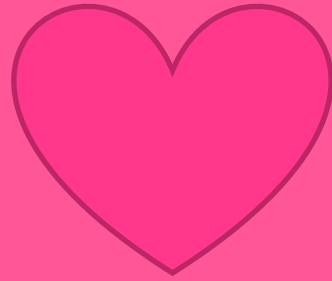

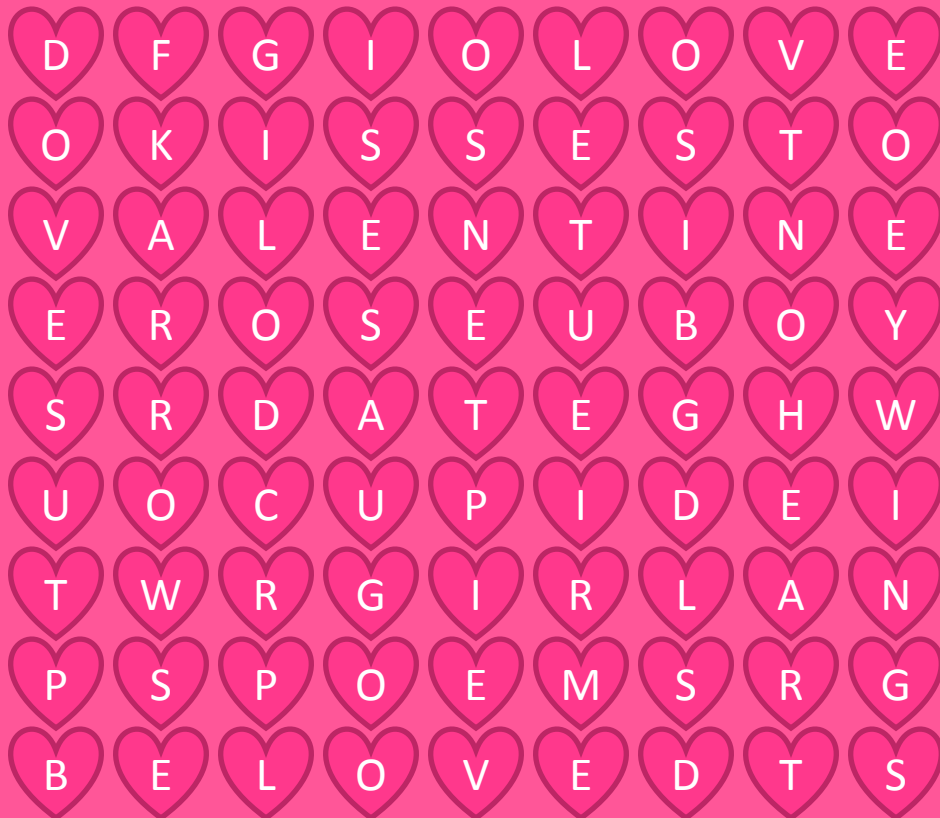
