- Memnun Oldum - Nice to meet you (pronounced "Memnun Oldun")



Negotiations with the Turks necessarily imply bargaining, and Turkish partners respect those who are able to conduct bargaining delicately and competently.



Making presents in the business etiquette of Turkey is not very accepted, and generous gifts are not the best sign of attention for Turkish businessmen.
