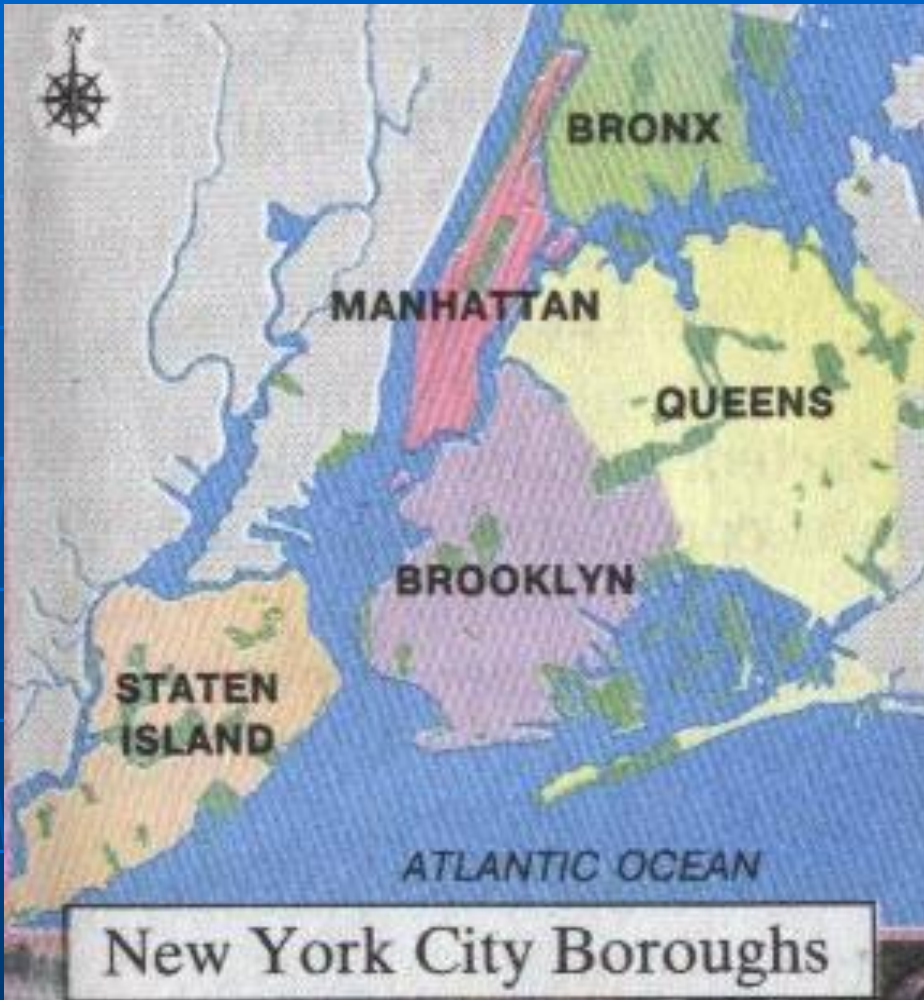

Museum of Modern Art

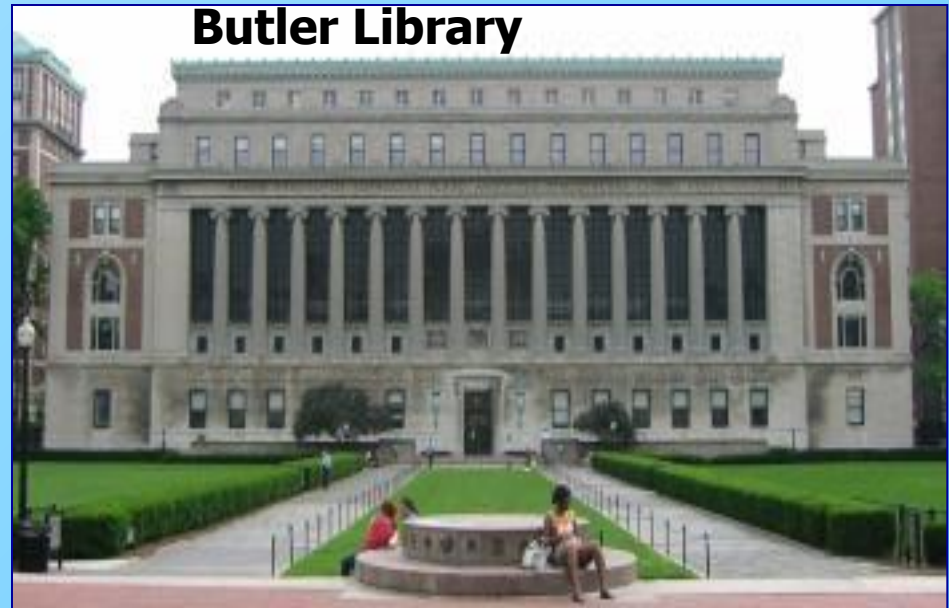
The Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) is a preeminent art museum.





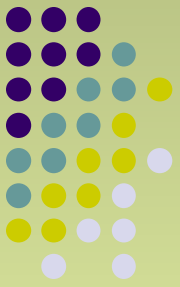
Columbia University

Columbia University is a private research university in the United States.



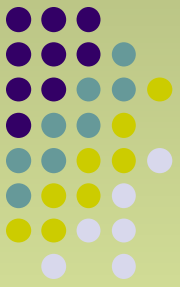
The Statue of Liberty.

The statue was France's gift to America, presented to the USA in 1886.

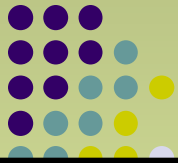
The Empire State building

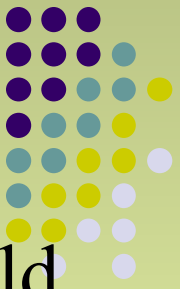


The Empire State Building is no longer the World's tallest building, but it is certainly one of the world's best loved skyscrapers.

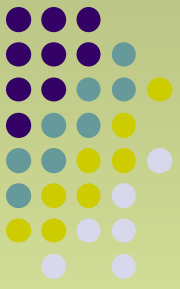

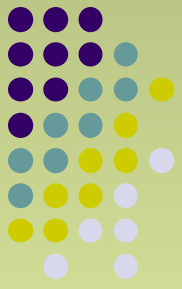
