

## Formatting

Tag	Description
<u>&lt;b&gt;</u>	Defines bold text
<u>&lt;em&gt;</u>	Defines emphasized text
<u>&lt;i&gt;</u>	Defines a part of text in an alternate voice or mood
<u>&lt;small&gt;</u>	Defines smaller text
<u>&lt;strong&gt;</u>	Defines important text
<u>&lt;sub&gt;</u>	Defines subscripted text
<u>&lt;sup&gt;</u>	Defines superscripted text
<u>&lt;ins&gt;</u>	Defines inserted text
<u>&lt;del&gt;</u>	Defines deleted text
<u>&lt;mark&gt;</u>	Defines marked/highlighted text
