- What countries make up the UK?

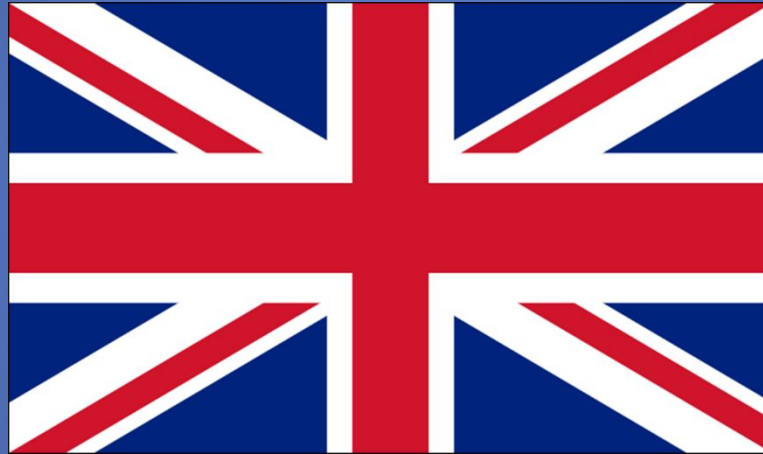


- Answer: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland

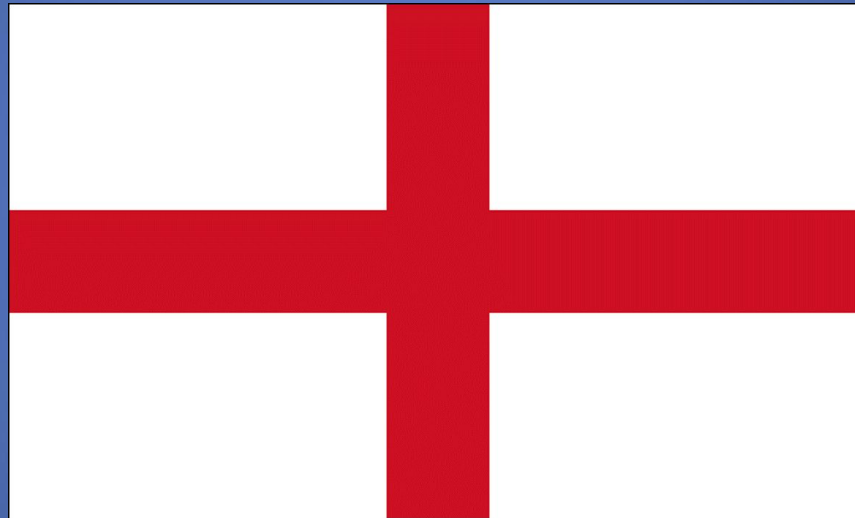
Famous People 5
