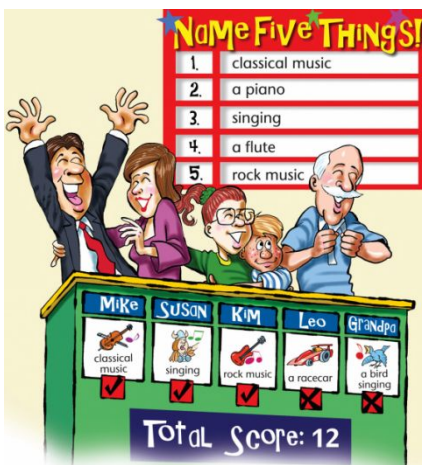
"I hope we win!" said Leo Smith.

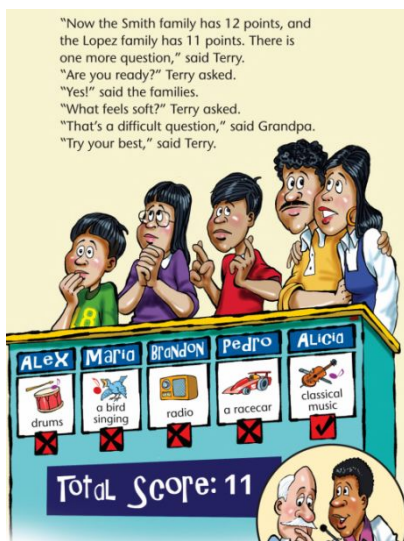

 "Now the Smith family has nine points. And the Lopez family has ten points!" said Terry. "What question is next?"



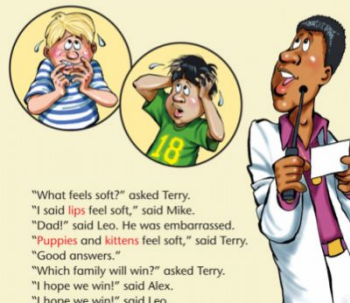
"Is it: *What sounds good?*?" asked Leo.

 "Try your best," said Terry.

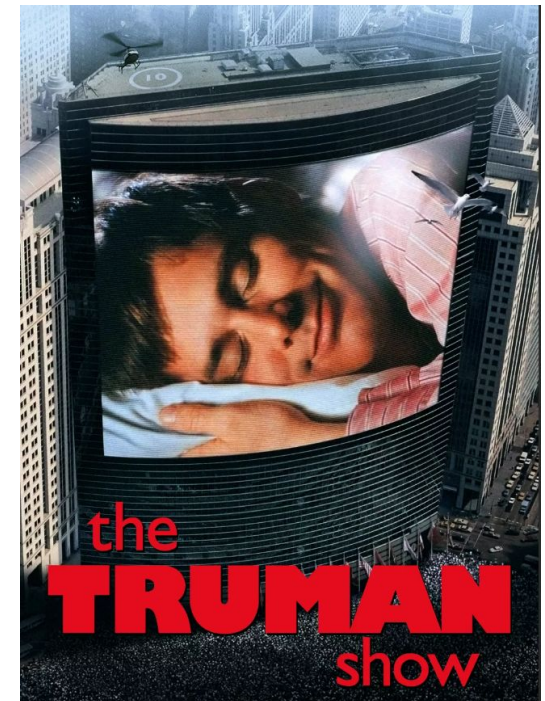
