





University Embankment



The long red-and- white building is the main building of St Petersburg State University (architect Trezzini, 1732). It's one of the oldest buildings in the city, designed in the early 18th century for the 12 ministries of Peter I known as "Twelve Collegia".








Mechnikov

In 1819 the University of St Petersburg was founded. Many outstanding Russian scientists, writers, public figures were among its graduates: Mendeleyev, the founder of the periodic table of elements; physiologists Pavlov, Mechnikov, Sechenov, writers Turgenev, Chernyshevsky, Nekrasov and others.

Here Lenin passed his exams as an extern student of the Law department in 1891. For more than 290 years, St Petersburg State University has been committed to advancing science and training highly qualified professionals.


