

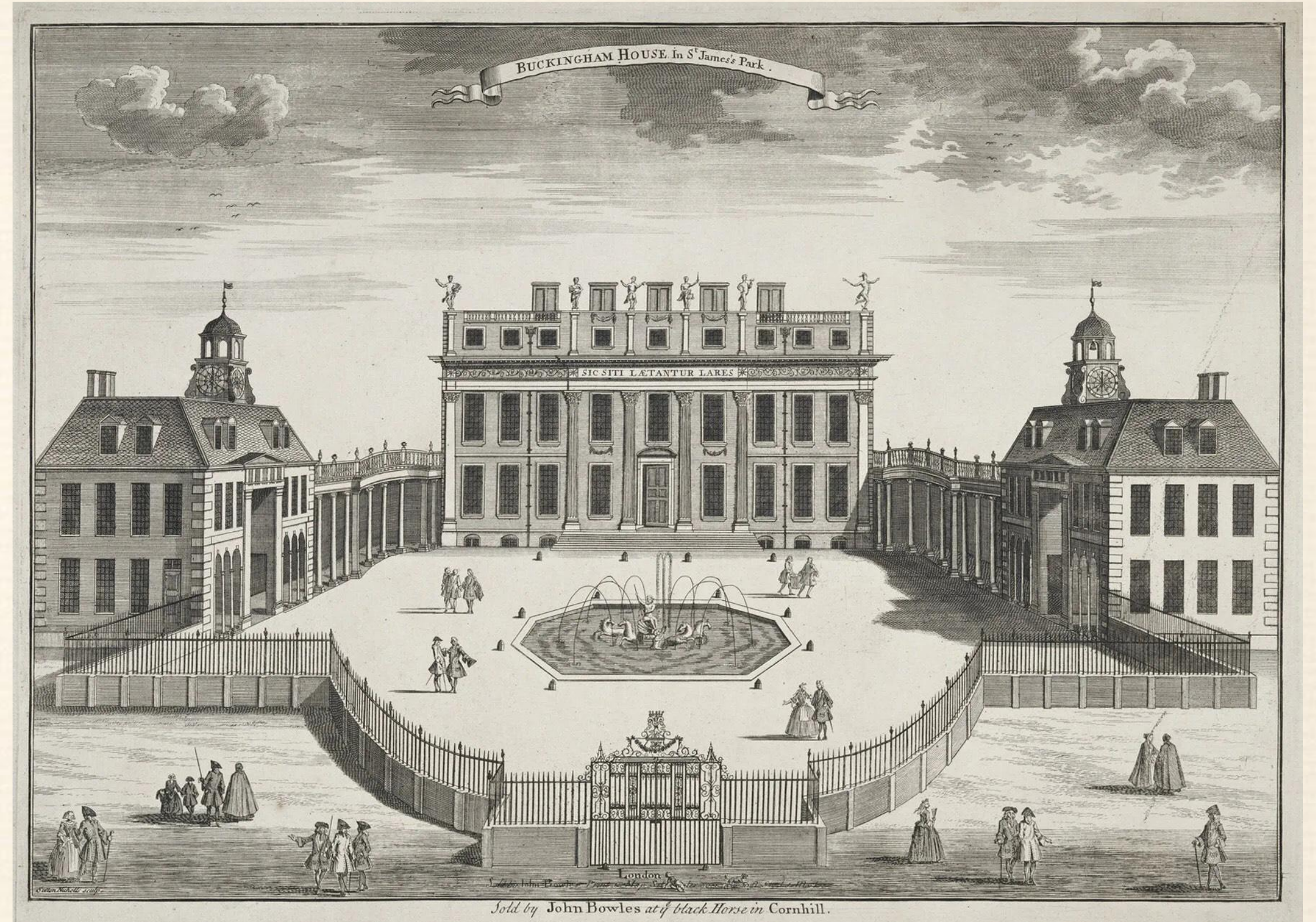


Buckingham Palace



# History

- Firstly, it was Buckingham House, 1703
- Acquired by King George 3, 1761
- The first monarch was Queen Victoria in 1837

- . During World War II a German bomb ruined a beautiful chapel



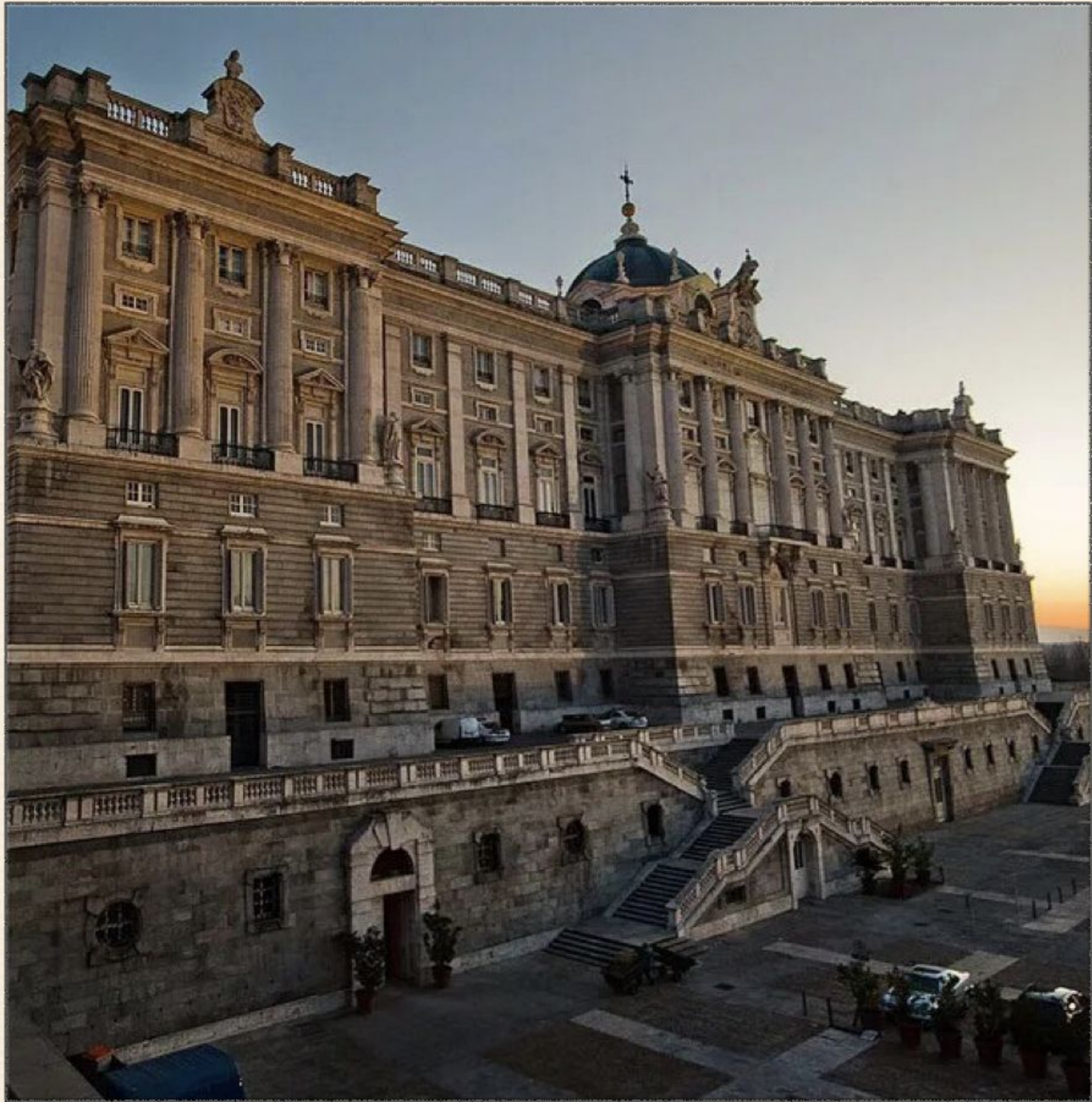


# What is inside?
