- There are 548 shops in Oxford Street.

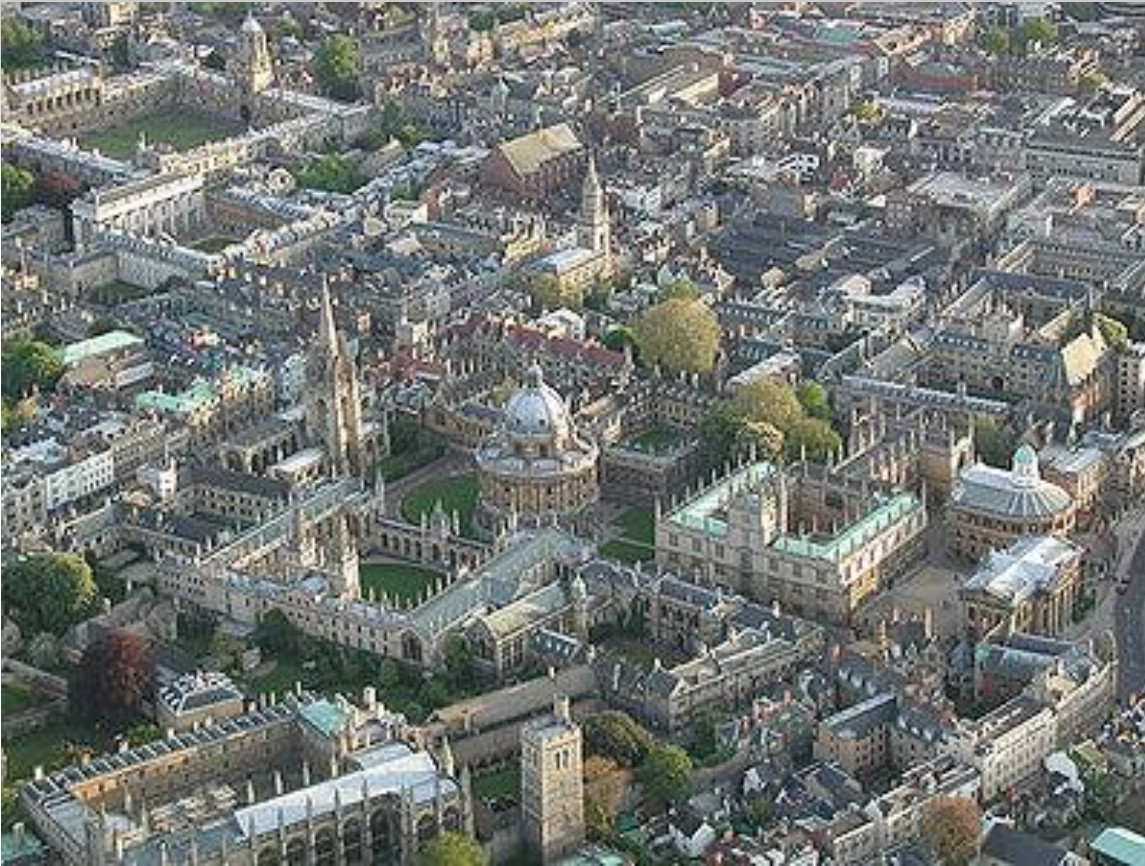
