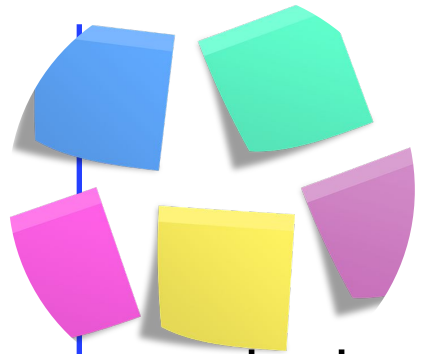
Policy and Assessment Rubrics for B1 level

- a mark of 50% or above are not allowed to retake.



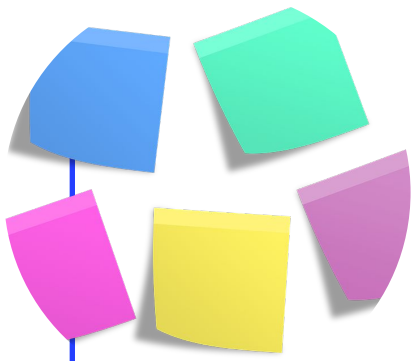
Preliminary preparation

- check access to the Microsoft Teams;
- if there are technical problems contact helpdesk@astanait.edu.kz or helpdeslit@astanait.edu.kz in advance;
- log into the Microsoft Teams 15 minutes before the start of the exam;
- open the course "English for Academic Purposes, 1st trimester" and go to "FINAL ONLINE EXAM";
- confirm your participation in the Microsoft Teams platform message box by sending the message "I confirm my presence at the online exam".



Preliminary preparation

- The Final Online Exam is conducted via a video call. A non-working camera or microphone is a reason for refusal to take the exam by the Examiner.
- An appropriate environment during the exam should be maintained (exclude the presence of distractions - strangers in the room and other background noises: TV, music, etc.).

- We ask you to observe the dress code.



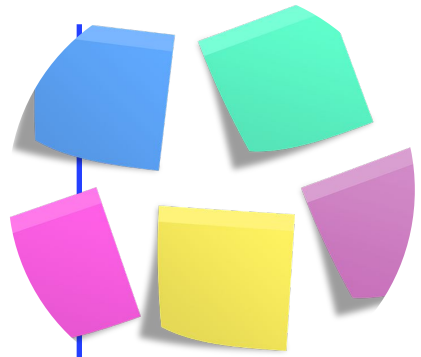
Participation in the online exam

- The assignment should be performed personally by the student, without the involvement of outside help and without discussing the assignment with other individuals.



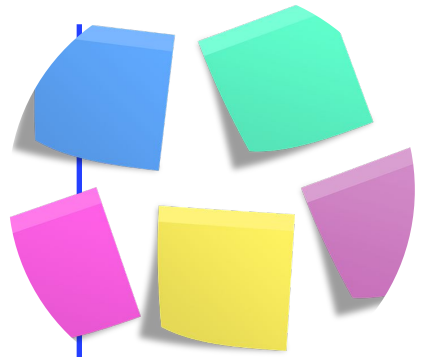
Online Final Exam Assessment Rubric and Criteria (B I level)

Content	
The definition of the invention and the information about the inventor are provided with references to reliable sources	4
Summaries of the history of the invention, stages of its development and its operation are given with references to reliable sources	4
Not less than three perspectives (represented as a mind map or table) are suggested with references to reliable sources	4
The questionnaire includes 10-12 questions of various of question types related to the topic “Inventions in IT/Technology”	4
Findings and data analysis are well-aligned and relate to the graph(s)	4



Online Final Exam Assessment Rubric and Criteria (B I level)

Structure	
Title page (slide) includes the following: the topic, the course name, the student's name and group number, the instructor's name, the university, the year.	4
Introduction is given in accordance with recommendation and include a hook, a context, an outline	4
Body reveals all the items of the Content Part of the given Assessment Rubric	4
Conclusion summarizes the presentation and epiphany would be welcomed.	4
Both in-text referencing and reference list are organized according to APA style (not fewer than 3 sources)	4

Design	
The overall number of slides is 10-12	4
All the slides are with headings	4
There are no more than 15-20 words per slide (except definitions).Bulleted lists or numbered lists are used for slide organization	4
Graphs/charts/tables are with captions and keys	4
The design (colors, images, animations) is not overloaded, easily visible	4
