Compound Nouns

- o A compound noun is made up of two or more words used together as a single noun.
- o You might see compound nouns written in one of three ways:

One single word: rooftop

Two or more separated words: window shade

A hyphenated word: brother-in-law

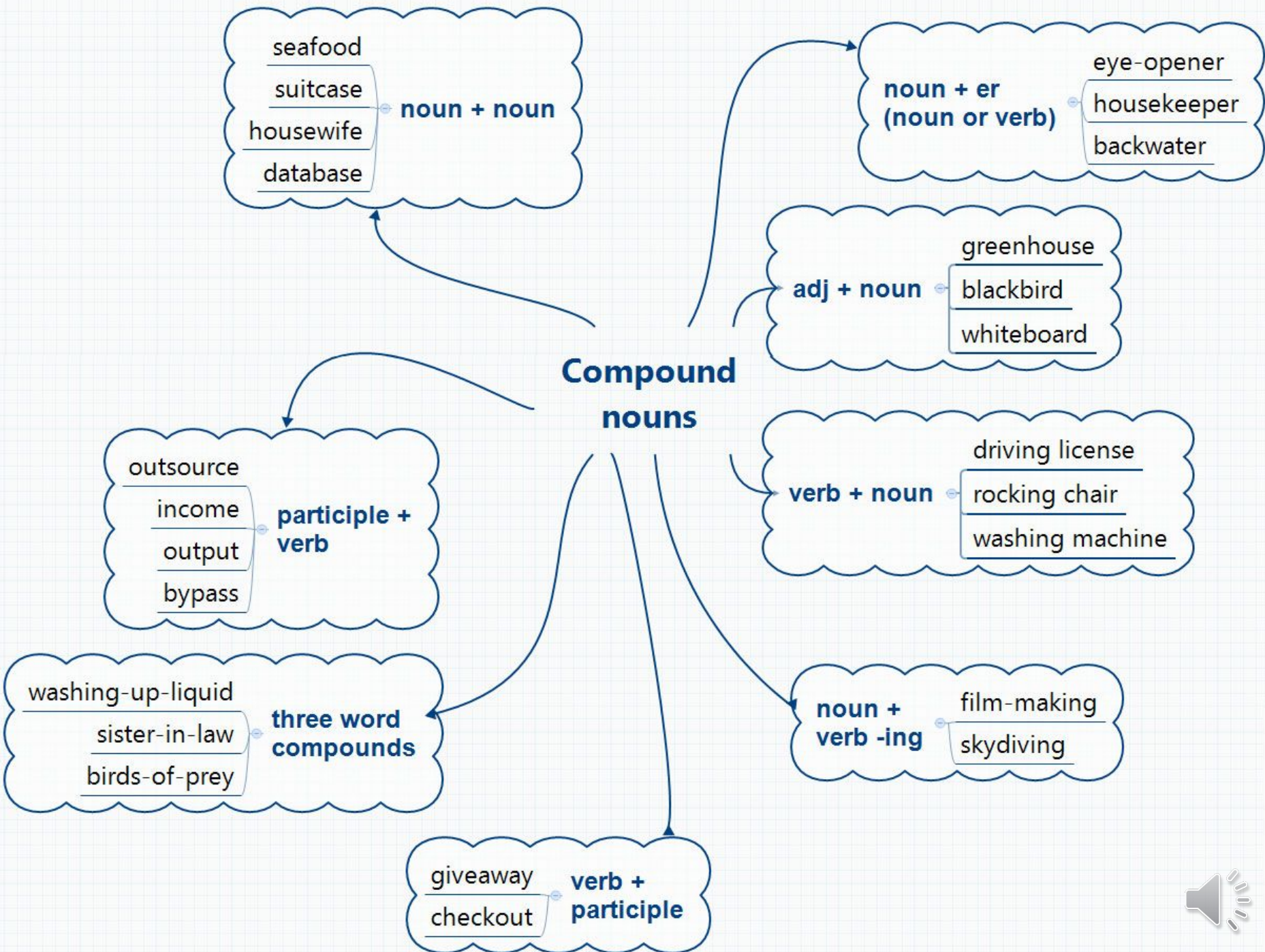
